		In July 2002, the Hospital's Board of Trustees adopted a Salary Continuation Plan (the "Plan"), in the form of a non-qualified retirement benefit for senior executives (currently seven persons) The retirement benefit provided by the Plan is supplementary to the Hospital's employee Pension Plan, Tax-Deferred Annuity Retirement Plan, 401(k) Plan and Social security retirement earnings. Benefits are calculated as the difference between the projected age-65 value of the aforementioned benefits and 75% of the lump sum at age 65. No benefits under the Plan are generally available for a senior executive who retires prior to his/her 65th birthday. Funding for the Plan began in 2002, and the Hospital first began accruing a liability for the Plan during the fiscal year ending 0 ctober 31, 2005. The Hospital's liability accrual is based on the assumption that all seven executives will be working until age 65. Given the short number of years between when the Hospital began accruing the benefits and when the first persons turn age 65, the accrual is disproportionate for the older senior executives. Mr. Richard W. Linneweh, Jr. is the President/CEO of Yakima Valley Memorial Hospital. As of 10/31/09, Mr. Linneweh is 66 years old and has been in his current capacity since 1977 and in other senior administrative capacities at the hospital since 1972. Upon reaching the age of 65 during the calendar year of 2008, but prior to the Hospital's fiscal year beginning 11/1/2008. Mr. Linneweh was paid \$2,461,282 from the plan. Mr. John G. Vornbrock is the Senior Vice President/CFO of Yakima Valley Memorial Hospital. As of 10/31/09, Mr. Vornbrock is 62 years old and has been in his current other senior administrative capacities at the Hospital since 1978. Mr. Vornbrock accrued benefits under the plan in the amount of \$154,844 during the 2008 calendar year.
