The Directors of The Fullerton Foundation, Inc. established the Fullerton Medical Scholarship Program in the year 1985.

I. INTRODUCTION

The Fullerton Medical Scholarship Program established by The Fullerton Foundation, Inc., has been in existence since 1985 and strictly adheres to well-settled objectives, procedures concerning the interviewing of nominees, selection of scholarship recipients, and the handling of the payment of scholarship amounts. The objective of the Fullerton Medical Scholarship Program, selection criteria, selection and interview process, and the value, payment and continuation of the scholarship are described hereafter.

II. OBJECTIVE

To identify and reward the student who demonstrates and projects the potential for development into a highly capable professional, and who is concerned with the total welfare of the society of which he/she is an active participant, as well as being a competent physician.

III. SELECTION CRITERIA

1. The nominee, or the immediate family of the nominee, must have been a resident, or are residents, of North Carolina or South Carolina for the past five (5) calendar years.

2. The nominee must have:

- (a) An undergraduate GPR minimum of 3.5 or better, and
- (b) A minimum score as shown below on each of the four sections of the American Medical College Admission Test

PLEASE INCLUDE A COPY OF THE NOMINEE'S COMPLETE "AMERICAN MEDICAL COLLEGE APPLICATION SERVICE" REPORT.

If a medical school does not require the AMCAS, the nominating medical school must provide a certification that the nominee has been accepted in its early admissions program.

It is not necessary to send a transcript of the grades of the nominee.

- 3. The nominee must have the potential for service in the health care field, which can be demonstrated by, but not limited to, leadership in high school, undergraduate school and the community, as well as knowledge of society and the problems and opportunities of the world today. Additionally, it is important for the nominee to have an awareness of his/her own capabilities and limitations, to be able to interact and effectively communicate with others, and to have a feeling of empathy for others.
- 4. A student may be nominated by only one medical school.

IV. SELECTION & INTERVIEW PROCESS

- 1. Each fully accredited four (4) year medical school in North Carolina:
 - (a) School of Medicine, Duke University Medical Center
 - (b) Brody School of Medicine, East Carolina University
 - (c) School of Medicine, University of North Carolina
 - (d) School of Medicine, Wake Forest University

and in South Carolina:

- (e) College of Medicine, Medical University of SC
- (f) School of Medicine, University of SC

will be invited to nominate one candidate for a Fullerton Medical Scholarship. Please see Section IV, Selection and Interview Process, Paragraph 4, Page 4 for nomination mailing deadlines.

- 2. Official nomination forms will be furnished to each of the six (6) eligible medical schools.
- 3. Each completed nomination form <u>must</u> be accompanied by <u>three</u> personal letters of recommendation, one of which must be by an officer or professor in the undergraduate college of the nominee. (Note: A letter signed by more than

one individual will be considered as <u>ONE</u> letter only.) Four (4) wallet-size prints of a recent photograph of the nominee should be included. Please do not

use a felt tip pen to write the name of the nominee on the back of the print.

4. Completed nomination forms, together with the required enclosures, should be postmarked on or before the deadline dates listed below and mailed to:

In order to ensure that each nominee meets the "Selection Criteria" described above, the Foundation requires that the nomination forms and required enclosures be submitted by the following Preliminary Nominating Deadline: **Postmarked March 9, 2009**.

Upon receipt, the Foundation will review the nominee's file to determine whether the Selection Criteria have been met. If the criteria have not been met, the nominating medical school will be notified of this so that the school may select a substitute nominee. In this event the nominating forms and required enclosures with respect to the substitute nominee must be submitted by the following Final Nominating Deadline: **Postmarked March 23, 2009**.

This procedure is intended to help ensure that each nominating medical school will have an appropriate nominee involved in the selection process.

- 5. There will be no discrimination on the basis of race, sex, creed, or national origin.
- 6. The six nominees will be invited for interviews to be held in Charlotte, North Carolina, presently scheduled for Saturday morning, April 18, 2009. Room reservations will be made for each nominee for Friday night, April 17, 2009. Details concerning the interview schedule will be sent by certified mail April 2, 2009 to each medical school Fullerton Scholarship contact and to each nominee using the name and address shown on the nomination form. Reimbursement for reasonable travel expenses (travel receipts, mileage, and meals personal telephone calls are excluded) of the nominees will be made to their respective nominating medical school on receipt, prior to June 11, 2009, of an expense statement from the nominating medical school of the nominee.

7. An Independent Selection Committee (the Committee) will conduct the interviews. The Committee will be composed of persons who are leaders in business, the

professions and civic life, with no association of any kind with The Fullerton Foundation, Inc.

- 8. After all interviews, the Committee will rank order only those nominees who have satisfied all the selection criteria set out in Section III above. Nominees will not be told their rankings. If a nominee has not satisfied all of the criteria, and therefore is not ranked, the Committee will document its reasons and provide the same to the Foundation staff. The top three nominees will be offered Scholarships. Each of the remaining nominees will be awarded a one-time \$1,000 honorary stipend, payable as described below to the medical school which made the nomination.
- 9. The medical school whose nominee is awarded a scholarship must accept the scholarship by May 20, 2009. This means that the medical school's nominee must commit to attending that medical school by that same date. A completed "Acceptance and Commitment," a copy of which is on Page 7 of this brochure, must be mailed by the medical school to The Fullerton Foundation, Inc., postmarked no later than May 20, 2009; if the "Acceptance and Commitment" is not completed and postmarked by this date, or if the medical school or nominee is not willing to accept or commit by this date, or if for any other reason the scholarship is not accepted by this date, the scholarship will be withdrawn and then awarded to the medical school which nominated the next ranking nominee.

V. <u>VALUE, PAYMENT AND CONTINUATION OF THE FULLERTON MEDICAL SCHOLARSHIP</u>

- 1. Three Fullerton Medical Scholarships will be awarded to three students entering first year medical school in August 2009.
- 2. The value of the scholarship will be \$20,000 each year, payable to the institution in North Carolina or South Carolina which nominates the student and where the nominee is enrolled. One-half (\$10,000) will be paid the first business day in August and the other half (\$10,000) the first business day in the following January. The payee institution will determine the distribution of these payments between tuition and expenses.
- 3. If the winner of a Fullerton Medical Scholarship maintains adequate academic performance each year in accordance with the enrollment standards at his/her medical school, continues to be enrolled as a full time medical student, and the medical school sends a statement each year certifying the same to The Fullerton Foundation, Inc., he/she will continue to receive a Fullerton Medical Scholarship for each of the remaining three years of medical school. It is the responsibility of the medical school to supply this information to The Fullerton Foundation, Inc. on a timely basis; if this information is not supplied timely the scholarship will be terminated.

4. A Fullerton Medical Scholarship will be payable only to the medical school nominating the student. A scholarship is not transferable to another medical school. If a student does not attend the medical school which nominated him/her,

the scholarship will be awarded instead to the medical school which nominated the next ranked student, as described above.

- 5. Each of the three medical schools whose nominee is not selected for a scholarship will receive a one-time \$1,000 stipend, payable to the medical school. On the first business day of August, 2009, The Fullerton Foundation, Inc. will send a check for \$1,000 to the medical school, to be applied against the tuition for the ensuing term of the student nominated by the medical school.
- 6. If a student whose nominating medical school is awarded a one-time \$1,000 honorary stipend does not attend that medical school, the stipend amount nevertheless will be paid to that nominating medical school for unrestricted use in its medical scholarship program.
- 7. Each institution is responsible for the proper disbursement or use of the funds (scholarships and stipends).

Guidelines for Grants

General Policy

The Foundation has adopted the following guidelines with respect to grants:

- 1. The Foundation's primary field of interest is health care and medicine with higher education secondary. While there are no fixed geographical limitations, the primary geographical areas of interest shall be South Carolina and North Carolina.
 - 2. The Foundation will not make grants to individuals.
 - 3. The Foundation will not make loans.
 - 4. The Foundation will not normally fund overhead and/or indirect costs.
 - 5. The Foundation does not normally fund "bricks and mortar" projects.
 - 6. The Foundation normally discourages recurring applications.
- 7. Endowment funds, debt retirement, and operating funds normally shall be unlikely candidates for assistance.
- 8. The Foundation shall receive, process, and make decisions on applications for grants without regard to age, creed, gender, national origin, race, or religion and will expect grantees to use Foundation funds likewise.
- 9. Challenge grants for projects that should have wide appeal to others may be of interest to the Foundation when they afford the opportunity for the merit of the project to be tested further by the response and support of others.
- 10. Declination of applications or recommendations shall not reflect adversely on applicants or projects.
- 11. To be eligible, an applicant must be an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code <u>and</u> must be either (a) a public charity as described in Section 509(a) (1), (2) or (3) of the Code or (b) an exempt operating foundation as described in Section 4940(d)(2) of the Code.

12. If the organization is a support organization as described in Section 509(a)(3) of the Code, the organization must submit a currently dated, written opinion letter from its legal counsel to the effect that the organization is a Type I, Type II, or functionally integrated Type III support organization as described in the Pension Protection Act of 2006 (and not a Type III support organization which is <u>not</u> functionally integrated with the supported organization). The letter must describe the organizational and operational aspects of the organization which reasonably lead to the opinion. The letter may not provide a mere representation as to the status of the organization without providing the basis and reasoning leading to the opinion.

Applications (Deadlines are April 1, August 1, and December 1)

Applications for grants must be in writing briefly showing:

- 1. Full disclosure of the applicant organization's working relationship, if any, with any for-profit organization (affiliate, corporate, partnership, contract, etc.) allowing or permitting any sharing of the grant funds or the benefits of the grant.
 - 2. The purpose of the grant.
 - 3. Budget projections and requirements.
 - 4. Other funding sources—expected, pledged, or paid.
 - 5. Plans for permanent financial support.
 - 6. Methods for evaluating project effectiveness.
- 7. Documentation of the federal tax status of the grant applicant, as described above in paragraph 7 of the General Policy, and of any organization with which the applicant has a working relationship allowing or permitting any sharing of the grant funds or the benefits of the grant.

Fullerton Medical Scholarships Program

The Fullerton Medical Scholarship Program is administered by each of the four medical schools in North Carolina and the two medical schools in South Carolina, each of whom selects a nominee for interview by an Independent Selection Committee. For specific application procedures, contact the admissions office of the particular medical school.
