Restated Articles of Incorporation

Exhibit A

- (1) The name of the Corporation is "Kennebec Estuary Land Trust".
- (2) The Corporation is organized as a public benefit corporation exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including particularly the following purposes:
 - (a) To promote for the benefit of the general public the preservation and enhancement of natural and other resources primarily in, but not limited to, the Kennebec Estuary and adjacent areas. These shall include land and water resources, the plant and animal life thereon, and scenic, cultural, agricultural, natural and historic sites and structures;
 - (b) To engage in and promote the scientific study of and education regarding natural and other resources;
 - (c) To use all property held or controlled by the Corporation and the net income derived therefrom for the benefit of the Kennebec Estuary and adjacent areas and for charitable, educational, low-impact recreational, conservation, scientific or historical purposes; and
 - (d) To obtain open space areas where the interaction of natural forces and conditions may be studied, to provide preserves for wildlife, agricultural and forest land, wetlands, and growth areas for marine, aquatic, and terrestrial life, and to demonstrate and teach the necessity of preserving our natural heritage by conservation and preservation so that present and future generations may enjoy it.
- (3) The minimum number of directors shall be seven (7) and the maximum number of directors shall be nineteen (19).

(4) Membership

(a) Eligibility: Any person, including any individual age 18 or over, trust, estate, partnership, association, company, corporation or public body who supports the purposes of the Corporation may become a member upon payment of dues. The Board from time to time shall determine the amount, and the time of payment of said dues; provided that payment of dues shall not be required more than once during each fiscal year established for the Corporation. The duties and privileges of membership shall be exercised by each member in person. Each member in good standing shall have one vote, however, not more than two members from any single household shall have the right to vote on any given matter.

- (b) Records of Membership: Membership will be so recorded on the books of the Corporation maintained by the Treasurer or duly authorized staff for that purpose with a record of the amounts of the dues paid.
- (c) Duties and Privileges: Members in good standing are entitled to all the benefits and privileges associated with membership. Each member in good standing shall be entitled to one vote at meetings, which may be cast in person given in accordance with procedures established from time to time by the Board. Only members in good standing are entitled to serve as Directors or Officers of the Corporation.
- (d) Termination of Membership: Membership shall terminate at the end of a fiscal year for which said member has paid dues, but shall be reinstated upon the payment of dues for the current fiscal year, effective upon receipt of such payment. A member may resign at any time. A member may be expelled upon a two-thirds affirmative vote of the Board, upon a determination, in its sole discretion, that such expulsion is in the best interests of the Corporation.
- (e) Categories of Memberships and Dues: The Board shall establish and define from time to time categories of membership such as, but not limited to, charter, life, organizational, individual, family, supporting and honorary, and establish a schedule of dues for the categories.
- (5) No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- (6) Other provisions of these articles including provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the Corporation, distribution of assets on dissolution or final liquidation and the requirements of the Internal Revenue Code section 501(c) are as follows:
 - (a) No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any Director or Officer of the Corporation, or any private individual, excepting solely such reasonable compensation that the Corporation shall pay for services actually rendered to the Corporation, or allowed by the Corporation as a reasonable allowance for authorized expenditures incurred on behalf of the Corporation, and no Director or Officer of the Corporation, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the Corporation (except that a Director or Officer may receive property of the Corporation in exchange for fair market value compensation to the Corporation).
 - (b) This Corporation is intended to exist in perpetuity, but in the event of dissolution of the Corporation or the termination of its activities, the assets of the Corporation remaining after the payment of all its liabilities shall be

distributed exclusively to one or more organizations organized and operated exclusively for such purposes as shall then qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended and as a charitable, religious, eleemosynary, benevolent or educational corporation within the meaning of Title 13-B, of the Maine Revised Statutes as amended, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

Any corporation succeeding to title to property or interest in property of the Corporation shall be required to conform to those restrictions or limitations of uses applicable thereto, and shall administer such properties in a manner compatible with the general purposes of the Corporation, insofar as this may be accomplished.

(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended.
