As a result, there is a high level of awareness and sensitivity among Board

members to any potential conflict.

We have required this disclosure by Board members for a number of years, but we did not require it of key employees in 2009. We will extend this practice to key employees this year.

and government agencies in New Hampshire. It has since been adjusted only

by annual cost-of-living increases.
