 Humanitarian Aid for Rural Development (HARD) HARD is a non-governmental organization (NGO) currently working in Bangladesh with the purpose of engaging in community transformation through eradicating poverty, eradicating illiteracy, and establishing God-fearing communities. The organization provides program services to over 5,300 families in rural parts of the country who are members of the NGO. Micro-loans are distributed to those in poverty to assist rural entrepreneurs in coming out of poverty with dignity. The Clinic provides free medical visits to the NGO doctor and a pharmacy with medicine provided at cost. Seven primary schools provide foundational skills education to young children. Humanitarian Aid such as food, mosquito nets, clothing, and agricultural support for farmers meet physical needs and show the love of Christ. These acts of compassion provide opportunities to build relationships of trust with villagers. As relationships are built our ministry has the opportunity to share the gospel message and disciple new believers.

4b (Code) (Expenses \$ 88,796 including grants of \$) (Revenue \$ 50,879)
 Mission Trips to Bangladesh Gospel For Muslims takes Christian volunteers on mission trips to Bangladesh where they support the work of the ministry there through sharing the Gospel with villagers, disciplining new believers, and distributing humanitarian aid such as micro-loans, school supplies, mosquito nets, food, and eyeglasses. In 2009, the ministry took volunteer teams (32 participants) on mission trips in February, August, and October.

 Domestic Ministry Gospel For Muslims equips Christian believers for outreach to Muslims through its annual MBB (Muslim Background Believers) conference (over 440 attendees in 2009) as well as through "GFM Institute" trainings in churches across the nation (4,000+ believers trained during 40+ speaking engagements). The ministry also engages Muslim Background Believers in ministry to Muslims within their local communities. Evangelistic and discipleship efforts extend to web-based outreach, including the site, www.WhyIsa.org, where dialogue about Jesus is facilitated between Muslims and Christians. GFM engages believers in prayer for Muslims through a weekly "prayer call" email communication that is distributed to over 2,000 contacts each week.


