- 5. The Trustees will not consider a proposal from an organization previously funded until a full report of the expenditures of the previous grant has been submitted.
- 6. The Trustees will not consider more than one application from an agency in the same calendar year, except for summer youth programs.
- 7. No grants will be made to national organizations or "annual giving campaigns".
- 8. No grants will be made to State or Federal agencies.
- 9. Grants may be made to a 501 (c) (3) organization for the benefit of another organization awaiting its own tax-exempt status.

 - c. Detailed program budget for which support is being requested
 - d. Starting & completion dates of proposed program and planned cash flow.
- 6. If an organization's proposal is complete and fits within the guidelines of The Stevens Foundations, the Director or other officer of that organization may be contacted to provide further details or information. Please include the name, address and telephone number of whom you wish contacted.
- 7. The Trustees of The Stevens Foundations generally meet monthly, with the exceptions of July and August. While awaiting a decision from The Stevens Foundations, applicants are encouraged to seek other sources of funding.
