



Article 5 - Upon the dissolution of the organization assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code), or shall be distributed to the Federal Government or to a state or local government for public purpose.

Article 6 - Dues - Shall be \$10.00 per year. Members in arrears will be placed on an inactive list at the end of the fiscal year. The member shall be notified that membership will be suspended. Honorary Members who are over 90 years of age and members who are handicapped shall be exempt providing they have been a member of good standing in the club for over 10 years.

Article 7 - Officers - shall be elected annually at the first meeting. There shall not be a set time limit on the tenure of each officer. They can be renominated and reelected by a vote from members attending the meeting. There shall be a President, Vice President, Recording Secretary, Correspondence Secretary, Financial Secretary, Treasurer and Sergeant-at-Arms.

Article 8 - Duties of Officers - President shall preside at all meetings and shall be honorary chairman of all committees. **Vice President** shall assist the President in her duties when called upon; Vice President will be President's lawful successor should a vacancy occur in the office of the President prior to the election date. The **Vice President**-will preside at all meetings during the absence of the President.

Recording Secretary shall have the responsibility of recording the minutes of the meetings and maintaining a record of each meeting.

Correspondence Secretary shall have the responsibility to take care of all correspondence which includes get-well cards and sympathy cards to members in event of an illness or death of a close relative (mother, father, husband or child).

Financial Secretary shall have the responsibility of collecting dues and keep and distribute to officers an update membership list including name, address and phone numbers of each member.

Treasurer shall be custodian of all monies received and distributed by the organization. All bills shall be paid by check and co-signed by the President. All check payment receipts shall be kept on file.

Sergeant-at-Arms shall preserve law and order at all club functions.

Scholarship Committee shall consist of (5) members. The executive board of officers will review all applications received for scholarships


Eligibility and Qualifications:

BY-LAWS OF THE POLANIE CLUB (REVISION 2010)

Article 1 - The name of this club shall be known as Polanie Club

Article 2 - Meetings - To be held the second Monday of each month at 6:30 PM with the exception of January, July, and August.

Article 3 - Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable religious, educational, and scientific purposes, the making of distributions to organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)

Article 4 - No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of section 501 (c) (3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code) or (b) by any organization, contributions to which *X*
