A notice by mail is sent out to the membership stating when nominations are to be held (always at the May monthly union meeting). After nominations have been made and nominations are closed, the president appoints an Election Judge and as many tellers as are required, who shall serve as the Election Board to conduct the election. No candidate for any office shall be eligible to serve on this board. After nominations have been made and those nominated are found to be qualified, the Election Board shall have ballots prepared, listing in alphabetical order the names of all candidates for each respective office beginning with the President and continuing in the order named in the IBEW Constitution. Such ballots shall not contain any identifying numbers or marks. All voting shall be by mail ballot. The Financial Secretary furnishes to the Election Judge not less than 10 days before the election, an alphabetical list of all members eligible to vote. All members in good standing and qualified shall be entitled to vote. The Executive Board shall decide the last day on which ballots shall be received, and the date, time and place when the ballots will be counted and this information shall be enclosed with the ballot sent to the members. The Executive Board of IBEW LU 2222 serve as trustees of the Benevolent Fund Trust for as long as they serve on the Executive Board of IBEW LU 2222.

Part VI - Line 7b - The trustees meet on the third Wednesday of each month to approve donations, bills and discuss any other matters brought before the trustees. Minutes are taken at this meeting and read to the membership of IBEW LU 2222 at the monthly union meeting which is held on the first Wednesday of each month. The members can accept or reject the minutes.
