We have audited the balance sheet (Part X) of UNITE HERE 34 Local FUE as of December 31, 2009, and the related statement of revenue, expenses and changes in net assets (Part I) and the statement of functional expenses (Part IX) for the year then ended included in the accompanying Internal Revenue Service Form 990. These financial statements are the responsibility of the Union's Executive Board. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.
