Aftereffects of the NDE can be disturbing to the experiencers as well as to their families, friends, and caregivers. To meet these special needs:
  - IANDS helps to organize support and interest groups (Friends of IANDS) across North America and in countries elsewhere in the world.
  - The Board of Directors of IANDS has periodic informal public gatherings at various locations.
  - IANDS holds an annual retreat for near-death experiencers.
