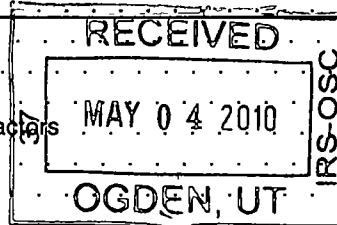

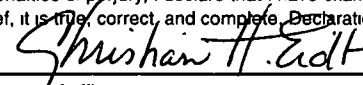

Statement to Part III

The objective of the Fund is to recognize through scholarships demonstrated achievement across the spectrum of academics, arts, athletics, and community service. Scholarships are paid directly to the recipient's college or university. The 2009 scholarships supported by Kevin's Fund are:

1. \$100,000 to a graduating senior at Norwalk HS with demonstrated achievement across the spectrum of academics, arts, athletics, and community and religious service. In addition up to \$4,000 was made available, at the discretion of the Scholarship Selection Committee, to award the outstanding achievements of finalists for the Norwalk High School scholarship.
2. \$6,000 to a junior at Boston College in the School of Management Honors Program who has demonstrated the unique combination of academic achievement, character, leadership, and school spirit similar to Kevin's.
3. \$4,000 to a graduating senior in the St. Jerome parish youth group with demonstrated commitment to community and religious service.
4. \$3,000 to a graduating senior at Norwalk HS who as a member of the Marching Band achieved the highest cumulative grade point average similar to Kevin's accomplishment.
5. \$1,000 to a graduating senior at Norwalk HS who as a member of the Jazz Ensemble has demonstrated leadership and character similar to Kevin.
6. \$1,000 to a graduating senior at Norwalk HS who as a member of the Orchestra has made an outstanding contribution to the orchestra and has made themselves a role model for others.
7. \$1,000 to a graduating senior at Norwalk HS who has made an outstanding contribution to Norwalk High School both as a scholar and as an athlete.

Kevin's Fund grants scholarships to individuals with demonstrated achievements in academics, athletics, arts, and community and religious service. All scholarships are payable to accredited United States colleges or Universities. The Fund provides both one time awards and awards payable over a four year college career. To maintain the latter awards, the recipient must meet certain academic standards and conduct standards within their school and their community.

During 2009 Kevin's Fund announced the availability of \$120,000 in scholarships to the class of 2009. This brings the value of scholarships awarded by the Fund since its inception to over \$1,027,750 awarded to 80 individuals.

During the academic year commencing in the fall of 2009 Kevin's Fund provided financial support to 17 students attending William & Mary, Columbia, Georgetown, Boston College (2), Vassar, University of Rhode Island, Syracuse, San Francisco, Temple (2), Stonehill, Connecticut (2), West Virginia, Oberlin and Bryant.
