The allocation of compensation paid by the DDMF and allocated to DDF is based on an annual survey and is shown in Note (3) below for informational purposes only. It should be noted that compensation includes SERP and SERP gross up payments as well as other taxable fringe benefits for Edward Henry and Elizabeth Fader. Benefits include 401(K) contributions, health insurance, dental and group life insurance. The salary allocation shown in Note (3) is included in the management fee shown on Line 23, Part I, Other Expenses.
