NOTE 1 - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

This summary of significant accounting policies of Scleroderma Foundation/Tri-State, Inc. Chapter is presented to assist in the understanding of the Organization's financial statements. The financial statements and notes are representations of Management, who is responsible for their integrity and objectivity. These accounting policies have been consistently applied in the preparation of the financial statements.

a) History and Activity:

The Scleroderma Foundation/Tri-State, Inc. Chapter is a charitable organization incorporated under the Laws of New York State on July 20, 1982. Prior to 1992, the Organization was known as the Scleroderma Society Of Greater New York, Inc. In 1992 the name was changed to Scleroderma Federation Of The Tri-State Area, Inc. Subsequently the name was officially changed to the Scleroderma Foundation/Tri-State, Inc. Chapter by a resolution of the Board of Directors on February 28, 2000. The purpose of the Organization is to provide funds for research, provide patient and family education and to create public awareness of the disease, Scleroderma.

b) Support and Revenue:

The Organization's support and revenue is generated through contributions, gifts, bequests and special fund raising events and activities. {See Note 4}. All contributions are considered to be available for unrestricted use unless specifically restricted by the donor. Amounts received that are designated for future periods or restricted by the donor for specific purposes are reported as temporarily restricted or permanently restricted support that increases those net asset classes. When a temporary restriction expires, temporarily restricted net assets are reclassified to unrestricted net assets and reported in the statement of activities as net assets released from restrictions.

c) Accounting Basis:

The financial statements of Scleroderma Foundation/Tri-State, Inc. Chapter are prepared on the accrual basis of accounting, whereby revenues are recognized when earned and expenses are recognized when incurred. Contributions are recorded when received unless susceptible to accrual. In accordance with Statement of Financial Accounting Standards No. 117, financial statements of not-for-profit organization, net assets are classified as unrestricted, temporarily restricted or permanently restricted as defined below:

c) Accounting Basis (Continued)

Unrestricted Net Assets:

Net assets that are not subject to donor-imposed stipulations.

Temporarily Restricted Net Assets:

Net assets subject to donor-imposed stipulations that may or will be met, either by actions of the Organization and/or the passage of time. When a restriction expires, temporarily restricted net assets are classified to unrestricted net assets and reported in the statement of activities as net assets released from restrictions.

Permanently Restricted Net Assets:

Net assets subject to donor-imposed stipulations that they will be maintained permanently by the Organization. Generally, the donors of these assets permit the Organization to use all or part of the income earned on any related investments for general or specific purposes.

d) Income Taxes:

On March 10, 1983 the Internal Revenue Service approved the Organization's application for exemption from Federal income taxes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Subsequently, New York State Department of Taxation and Finance, State of New Jersey Department of The Treasury, and the State of Connecticut have approved the Organization's application for exemption from corporate franchise taxes.

e) Estimates:

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

NOTE 1 - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED):

f) Cash and Cash Equivalents:

- a) The Organization maintains cash balances at several banks. Accounts at each institution are insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation up to \$250,000.
- b) The Organization maintains an account with NBT Bank Trust and Investment Division. The account contains Cash, Federal Money Market Fund, Certificates of Deposit and US Treasury Notes. The Federal Money Market Fund is collateralized dollar for dollar with government securities. The US Treasury Notes are backed by the US Government and the Certificates of Deposit are backed with FDIC Insurance.
- c) At times the balances in each account may exceed federally insured limits. The Organization has not experienced any losses in such accounts and believes it is not exposed to any significant credit risk.

NOTE 2 - INVESTMENTS:

Investments are stated at market value at the balance sheet date. Dividends and interest are accrued as earned and recorded as unrestricted revenue unless income is restricted by the donor. Unrealized changes in market value are disclosed below. The unrealized gain or loss for the current period is reported as investment income.

NOTE 2 - INVESTMENTS (CONTINUED):

During 2000 a member of the Organization made a contribution to the Scleroderma Foundation/Tri-State, Inc. Chapter by the transfer of a variable annuity naming the Organization as owner and beneficiary. The annuity contract was surrendered on December 31, 2009 for the full cash value of \$83,144 as outlined below and in Note 7.

NOTE 3 - PROPERTY AND EQUIPMENT:

Property and equipment are stated at cost. Depreciation is computed using the Modified Accelerated Cost Recovery System over the estimated useful lives (5-7 years) of the related assets. Cost and the related accumulated depreciation are deducted from the accounts on retirement or disposal and any resulting gain or loss is reflected in income. Maintenance and repairs are charged to expense when incurred. Betterments and major renewals or replacements are capitalized if material. Obsolete fully depreciated fixed assets were written off in 2006. The cost of equipment under ten thousand dollars is shown as functional expense in the current period.

NOTE 4 - SPECIAL FUND RAISING EVENTS:

During the current year, the Organization has held a number of special fund raising events as listed on Schedule I. Each special fund raising event has contributed to the public awareness of the disease, Scleroderma. The net proceeds from each event are used in achieving the Organization's exempt purpose.

NOTE 5 - FUNCTIONAL EXPENSES:

The allocation of functional expenses between program services, management and general and fund raising as per schedule II has been determined by management of the Organization. Forty-five percent of common expenses have been allocated to both program service and fund raising. The remaining ten percent of these expenses have been allocated to management and general. This estimated allocation of common expenses has been determined by management.

NOTE 6 - OPERATING LEASE:

The Organization leases its facility located in Binghamton, New York under a two year lease for \$1,025 per month commencing on October 1, 2008 and ending September 30, 2010. Rental cost for the year ended December 31, 2009 totaled \$12,260.
