

AMENDED AND RESTATED BY -LAWS

OF

THE LOUIS AND HAROLD PRICE FOUNDATION, INC

AS OF <u>August</u> 20, 2009

#### ARTICLE 1

#### OFFICES OF CORPORATION

The location of the principal office of the Corporation shall be in the city of Louisville in the State of Colorado

# ARTICLE II

# **MEMBERS**

# Section 1 - Composition, Admission and Voting Rights

The Corporation shall have two classes of Members – Class A and Class B. Only the issue of Harold Price and Pauline Price who satisfy Membership Eligibility Requirements shall be eligible to be appointed as either Class A or Class B Members (except as provided in paragraph 3(e)(n)(C)(II) of this Section 1)

# 2 Class A Member

- (a) The initial Class A Member shall be Linda Vitti Herbst
- (b) Additional Class A Members shall be elected by majority vote of the acting Class A Members or if there are no Class A Members by unanimous vote of the Class B Members (such vote to be conducted pursuant to the voting and quorum provisions of paragraph 3(e) of this Section 1)
- (c) Each Class A Member shall have three votes for all matters to be voted upon by the Members and shall be counted as three members for any required quorum
- 3 Class B Members
- (a) The initial Class B Members shall be Lisa Beshkov and Bonnie Vitti (each a "Daughter Member")

2

- (b) Until the death or incapacitation of Linda Vitti, Linda Vitti shall have the sole power to appoint additional Class B Members
  - (c) Upon the death or incapacitation of Linda Vitti
  - (i) If the Members have adopted provisions which were incorporated into the Bylaws of the Corporation specifying the manner in which new Class B Members shall be designated for admission, such provisions shall be effective, and new Class B Members snall be admitted in accordance with the requirements of such provisions. Such provisions may be adopted prior to or after the death or incapacitation of Linda Vitti by majority vote of the Members (such vote to be conducted pursuant to the voting and quorum provisions of paragraphs 2(c) and 3(e) of this Section 1)
  - (11) If no such By-law provisions then exist, or if any such provisions cannot be effectuated new Class B Members may be admitted as follows
    - (A) At any time during her lifetime, each Daughter Member may designate any one or all of the individuals included among her issue to become additional Class B Members of the Corporation. Such designations may be made either to take effect immediately upon designation, if such designee satisfies Membership Eligibility Requirements, or prospectively to take effect upon the happening of some event, such as satisfaction of Membership Eligibility Requirements or the death or incapacitation of the designation be made effective prior to the death or incapacitation of Linda Vitti
    - (B) After the death of any Daughter Member, the individuals included among the issue of such Daughter Member who shall then be acting as Class B Members may, at any time, by majority vote among them designate one or more individuals who shall also be included among the issue of such Daughter Member and who shall satisfy Membership Eligibility Requirements as additional Class B Members of the Corporation
    - (C) If at any time, all of a Daughter Member and those included among her issue who shall be designated as Members shall have died, resigned or become incapacitated
      - (I) Each individual included among the living issue of such Daughter Member who satisfies Membership Eligibility Requirements shall be admitted as an additional Class B Membe:
      - (II) If none of such Daughter Member's surviving issue shall satisfy Membership Eligibility Requirements or shall be willing to act as a Class B Member, such person, who need not be included among the issue of Harold Price and Pauline Price but who shall otherwise satisfy Membership Eligibility Requirements, who shall have been designated in writing by such Daughter Member (or if such Daughter Member shall not have made such a designation by a majority of the most recently acting Class B Members who shall have been included among the issue of such Daughter Member or if such Class B Members also shall not nave made

such a designation, by the most recently acting Class B Member who shall have been designated pursuant to this paragraph 3(c)(u)(C)(II)) snall be admitted as a Class B Member, provided, however, that if any individual included among the issue of such Daughter Member should subsequently satisfy Membership Eligibility Requirements and be willing to act as a Class B Member, each such individual who shall so satisfy Membership Eligibility Requirements and be so willing to act shall then be admitted as a Class B Member (even if such individual shall have previously been eligible but had declined to act) and any individual designated and acting as a Class B Member pursuant to this paragraph 3(c)(ii)(C)(II) who shall not be included among the issue of such Daughter Member shall cease to act as such

- (III) Upon the death of the survive of all of the individuals included among the issue of any Daughte Member, any individual designated and acting as a Class B Member pursuant to paragraph 3(c)(1)(C)(11) of this Section 1 shall cease to act as such
- (d) Any designation made pursuant to paragraphs 3(c)(n)(A), 3(c)(n)(B) or 3(c)(n)(C) of this Article EIGHTH shall be made in writing and delivered to the President or the Secretary of the Corporation. Any individual so designated shall be notified in writing by the President or the Secretary of the Corporation of such designation within 30 days of receipt of such designation and, before being admitted as a Member, shall be required to execute and deliver to the President or Secretary of the Corporation a written instrument consenting to membership within 90 days of the effective date of such designation. Until such written consent is received or such 90 days expire (whichever comes first), no vote by the Members on any issue shall be valid.
- (e) Each Daughter Member and any additional or successor Class B Members included among the issue of such Daughter Member or designated pursuant to paragraph 3(c)(1)(C)(II) of this Section 1 to represent such Daughter Member's family interest in the Corporation shall share a single collective vote for all matters to be voted upon by the Members (except as provided in paragraph 3(c)(1)(B) of this Section 1 and the first clause of paragraph 3(c)(1)(C)(II) of this Section 1, both of which paragraphs refer to matters to be voted upon which relate solely to the representation of a particular Daughter Member's family as Class B Members) and shall be counted as a single member for any required quorum
- A person shall be deemed to satisfy Membership Eligibility Requirements if he or shc (a) has attained the minimum membership age, as hereinafter defined, (b) is not suffering from any permanent incapacity, as hereinafter defined, (c) has graduated from an accredited college or university and (d) is employed
- 5 For purposes of this Section 1, the following terms shall have the following meanings
- (a) The term "permanent incapacity" of a person shall mean any physical or mental condition which, in the written opinion of a licensed medical doctor who is treating such person and who is not related by blood or marriage to any Member or to any Trustee, permanently prevents such person from being able to carry out his or her responsibilities as a Member, rationally and prudently

- (b) The term 'minimum membership age" shall mean such age, but no less than twenty-one (21) years and no greater than thirty (30) years, as may be specified from time to tune in the By-laws of the Corporation as the minimum membership age, provided, however, that if no such specification has been made in the By-laws of the Corporation, the 'minimum membership age" shall be the age of twenty-five (25) years
- (c) The term "issue" shall mean lineal descendants of all degrees and shall include both natural born and adopted issue, provided, however, that in the case of adoption of a child, such term shall be limited to persons who were younger than twelve (12) years of age at the date of adoption. In no event shall the term 'issue" include any foster child or stepchild or the issue thereof, unless such foster child or stepchild shall have been adopted by the foster parent or stepparent prior to such foster child or stepchild having attained twelve (12) years of age.

#### Section 2 - Resignation

Any Member shall be entitled to resign as a Member at any time by sending a written notice of resignation to the President of the Corporation at its principal office

# Section 3 - Vacancies

In the event of the death or resignation of any Member, the remaining Members shall, if they choose to do so, fill such vacancy, subject to the requirements of Section 1 of this Article, by vote at any regular or special meeting of the Members or by unanimous written consent

#### Section 4 - Annual Meeting

The annual meeting of the Members shall be held at such date during each year as shall be selected by the Chairman of the Board or by a majority of the Members but in no event later than May 31s of each year

#### Section 5 - Notices of Annual Meetings

Notices of annual meetings shall be given to each Member no more than thirty (30) days and no less than (10) days prior to the date of each such meeting. Such notices shall be given by regular U.S. mail or by express mail or private courier.

# Section 6 - Special Meetings

Special Meeting of the Members may be called by the President or by the Chairman of the Board or by any two (2) Members on ten (10) days' prior written notice delivered to each Member either personally or by express mail or private country

# Section 7 - Place of Meeting, Quorum Voting, etc.

The Members may hold their meetings, annual or special, at such place or places as may be selected by the Chairman of the Board or by a majority of the Members and may, at any such meeting, transact any and all business. Except as otherwise required by law

(a) The presence in person of a majority of the Members shall be necessary to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting of the Members, and

(b) Any action taken or authorized by a vote of the majority of the Members who are present at any meeting duly called and convened at which a quorum is present, shall have the same force and effect as if all of the Members had been present and had taken or authorized such action. If less than a quorum is present at any meeting, the Members who are present may adjourn the meeting to a different date in which case the Secretary shall give notice to all of the Members of the date, time and place of the adjourned meeting.

#### Section 8 - Waiver of Notice

Any Member may waive notice of any meeting and the attendance of each Member at any meeting shall constitute a waiver of notice of such meeting

#### Section 9 - Written Consent and Other Rights and Powers

Nothing contained in these By-Laws shall be construed to restrict the Members from acting by unanimous written consent

# ARTICLE III

#### TRUSTEES

#### Section 1 - Number and Qualifications

The Board of Trustees shall consist of not less than three (3) nor more than nine (9) persons each of whom shall be at least twenty-one (21) years of age. Within such limitation, the Members shall, from time to time, determine the number of persons who shall constitute the Board of Trustees. Such number, until changed by the Board, shall be nine (9). No decrease in the number of Trustees shall shorten the term of any incumbent Trustee.

#### Section 2 - Election

The Trustees of the Corporation shall be elected by the Members at each annual meeting of the Members as heretofore provided. The Trustees elected shall hold office until the next annual meeting of the Members and until their successors are elected and qualified.

#### Section 3 - Powers

The property, business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed and controlled by the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees shall have in addition to the powers and authority expressly conferred upon it by these By-Laws the right, power and authority to exercise all such powers and do all such acts and things as may be exercised or done by it as the board of a corporation organized under the Noi-For-Profit Corporation Law of the State of New York but subject nevertheless to the provisions of the Corporation's Certificate of Incorporation and these By-Laws

#### Section 4 - Vacancies

If the office of any Trustee becomes vacant by reason of death, resignation, disqualification or mability to act, or if there snall be any newly created trusteeship resulting from an increase in the number of Trustees, the Members may elect a successor or additional Trustee, as the case may be, who shall hold office until the next annual meeting of the Members and his successor shall have been elected and qualified

#### Section 5 - Salaries and Compensation

No Trustee shall receive any remuneration for acting as a Tristee

#### Section 6 - Contracting with the Corporation

Any Trustee of the Corporation may be interested directly or indirectly, in any contract with the Corporation provided that such contract is approved by a majority vote of the entire Board of Trustees and does not result in the imposition of a tax pursuant to Section 4941 of the Internal Revenue Code

#### Section 7 - Monetary Powers

The Board of Trustees shall designate the trust companies or banks in which the money or securities of the Corporation shall be deposited and they shall designate the manner in which the funds of the Corporation are to be expended

#### ARTICLE IV

#### MEETINGS OF TRUSTEES

#### Section 1 - Annual Meeting

The Board of Trustees shall hold an annual meeting during each calendar year immediately following the end of the annual meeting of the Members at which the Board of Trustees is elected

## Section 2 - Special Meetings

Special meetings of the Trustees may be called by the President or by any two (2) Trustees on ten (10) days' prior written notice delivered to each Trustee either personally or by express mail or private course:

# Section 3 - Place of Meeting, Quorum, etc.

The Trustees may, as from time to time determined by them by resolution duly adopted, hold their meetings, annual or special, at the office of the Corporation or at any other place and may, at any such meeting, transact any and all business pertaining to the Corporation. Unless otherwise provided in the notice of the meeting, all meetings of the Trustees shall be held at the

principal office of the Corporation Except as otherwise required by law or under the Certificate of Incorporation or under other provisions of these By-Laws

- (a) the presence in person of one third (1/3) of the Trustees shall be necessary to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting, and
- (b) any action taken or authorized by a vote of a majority of the Trustees present at any meeting duly called and convened at which a quorum is present shall have the same force and effect as if all the Trustees had been present and had taken or authorized such action

If less than a quorum is present at any meeting, the Trustees who are present may adjourn the meeting to a different date in which case the Secretary shall give notice to all of the Trustees of the time and place of the adjourned meeting. No person who is both an officer and Trustee of the Corporation shall participate in any vote or decision of the Trustees authorizing the distribution of funds of the Corporation to any organization which is exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, if, at such time, such person is an officer of such organization

#### Section 4 - Waiver of Notice

Any Trustee may waive notice of any meeting and the attendance of such Trustee at any meeting shall constitute a waiver of notice of such meeting

#### Section 5 - Written Consent and Other Rights and Powers

Nothing contained in these By-Laws shall be construed to restrict the Trustees from acting by unanimous written consent, as provided in Section 708 of the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law or from exercising any other rights and powers specified therein.

#### ARTICLE V

#### **OFFICERS**

# Section 1 - Designation of Officers

The officers of the Corporation shall be chosen by the Board of Trustees at the annual meeting of the Board of Trustees and shall be a Chairman of the Board, a President, one or more Vice-Presidents a Secretary and a Treasurer. Any two offices may be held by the same person except the office of President. None of the aforementioned officers need be Trustees except the Chairman of the Board and the President, both of whom shall be Trustees. The Board may also appoint such assistant officers and agents as it shall deem necessary none of whom need be Trustees.

#### Section 2 - Salaries

A salary may be paid to any officer of the Corporation provided that it is approved by the vote of a majority of the Members or of the entire Board of Trustees

#### Section 3 - Contracting with the Corporation

Any officer of the Corporation may be interested, directly or indirectly, in any contract with the Corporation, provided that such contract is approved by the vote of a majority of the Members or of the entire Board of Trustees and does not result in the imposition of a tax pursuant to Section 4941 of the Internal Revenue Code

#### Section 4 - Removal of Officers

Any officer elected by the Board of Trustees may be removed with or without cause at any time by the affirmative vote of a majority of the Members or of the entire Board of Trustees

#### Section 5 - Vacancies

A vacancy in any office by reason of death, resignation, removal, disquahtication or otherwise may be filled by the Board of Trustees for the unexpired portion of the term

#### ARTICLE VI

# POWERS AND DUTIES OF OFFICERS

#### Section 1 - The Chairman of the Board

The Chairman of the Board shall be the chief executive officer of the Corporation. He shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Trustees. He shall have general supervision, direction and active management of the business and affairs of the Corporation. He shall see that all orders of resolutions of the Board of Trustees are carried into effect. He shall execute all contracts, deeds, bonds and other instruments in writing authorized by the Board of Trustees.

#### Section 2 - The President

The President shall have such powers relating to the supervision, direction and active management of the business and affairs of the Corporation as the Chairman of the Board may, from time to time delegate to the President. In addition, in the event of the death, disability or resignation of the Chairman of the Board, the President shall be entitled to exercise all of the powers which had been vested in the Chairman of the Board under the By-Laws and shall be entitled to continue to exercise all such powers until a new Chairman of the Board has been elected

# Section 3 - The Vice-President

During the absence or disability of the President, the Vice-Presidents, in the order designated by the Board of Trustees, shall exercise all of the functions of the President. Each Vice-President shall have such powers and discharge such duties as may be assigned to him from time to time by the Board of Trustees.

#### Section 4 - The Treasurer

The Treasurer shall have the custody of all the funds and securities of the Corporation. He shall take such steps as may be necessary to collect moneys becoming due to the Corporation. When necessary and proper he shall endorse, on behalf of the Corporation, all checks, notes or other obligations and evidences of the payment of money payable to the Corporation or coming into his possession, and shall deposit the funds arising therefrom, together with all other funds of the Corporation coming into his possession, in such banks as may be selected as the depositaries of the Corporation, or properly care for them in such manner as the Board of Trustees may direct. Whenever required by the Board of Trustees or by the President, he shall exhibit a complete and true statement of his cash account and of the securities and other property in his possession, custody and control. He shall enter regularly in the books belonging to the Corporation and to be kept by him for such purpose an accurate account of all money received and paid by him on account of the Corporation together with all other business transactions of the Corporation. He shall perform all duties which are mordent to the office of a treasurer of the Corporation's type, subject, however, at all times to the direction and control of the Board of Trustees and President

#### Section 5 - The Secretary

The Secretary shall act as Secretary at all meetings of the Members and of the Board of Trustees. The Secretary shall keep all of the records of the Corporation under the supervision of the President and the Board of Trustees, including the permanent records of all minutes of meetings of the Members and Trustees, which minutes shall be signed by him as Secretary. He shall have charge of all such additional books and papers as the Board of Trustees may direct. He shall, in general, perform all such duties as are incident to the office of a Secretary of a Type B not-for-profit corporation organized under the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law of the State of New York.

#### Section 6 - Assistant Officers and Agents

Any Assistant Secretary, Assistant Treasurer or other assistant officers or agents of the Corporation snall be under the direct supervision of the person whom they are appointed to assist or on whose behalf they are appointed to act unless otherwise provided by the Board of Trustees They snall have such powers and perform such duties as may be assigned to them from time to time by the Board of Trustees

# ARTICLE VII

# COMMITTEES

The Board of Trustees shall determine and appoint or approve committees of such Board and the term, powers, duties and compensation (if any) of each

# ARTICLE VIII

# FISCAL YEAR

The fiscal year of the Corporation shall be the calendar year

# ARTICLE IX

# CORPORATE SEAL

The Corporation shall have a corporate seal, circular in form, which shall have inscribed thereon the name of the Corporation and the words, "Corporate Seal" and "New York" and the year of its incorporation. The Board of Trustees may change the form of this seal in its discretion.

# ARTICLE X

#### AMENDMENT TO BY-LAWS

The Members shall have general power to make, alter amend and repeal the By-Laws of the Corporation

# ARTICLE XI

# REQUIREMENTS OF CONFIDENTIALITY

All meeting discussions, minutes of the Corporation, financial documents and other proprietary information of the Corporation are to be kept in strict confidence by each Member, Trustee and Officer of the Corporation and shall not be disclosed to any third party other than pursuant to the regular course of business and as required by law Improper disclosure of confidential information by any Member. Trustee or Officer of the Corporation shall be sufficient grounds for immediate expulsion or removal
