On the Location of Applicants: As a rule, The Roothbert Fund does not make Scholarship Grants except to applicants whose current or permanent address is located in one of the following States of the United States and applicants planning to move to one of such States prior to March 1 of the year in which the application is made: Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Rhode Island, Massachusetts, Connecticut, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Delaware, Maryland, District of Columbia, Virginia, West Virginia, or North Carolina. It is probably counter-productive to submit an application if you live outside this area
- 2. On Recommendation Letters: Each application must be accompanied by three (3) recommendation letters from non-family members. Each letter must be originally signed, dated a current date and be addressed to The Roothbert Fund. Submission of recommendation letters addressed "to whom it may concern" or that were originally intended for other purposes will not carry as much weight with the Scholarships Committee.
