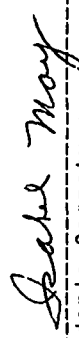

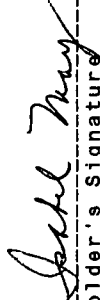

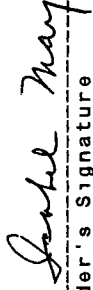

5. Time Warner Inc. has received a private letter ruling from the Internal Revenue Service to the effect that the distribution of shares of AOL Inc. common stock qualifies as a tax-free distribution under section 355 of the Code.
