IF THE PROPOSAL IS WITHIN THE FOUNDATION'S CURRENT INTERESTS. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION INCLUDING A BUDGET FOR THE PROJECT, AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND AN IRS DETERMINATION LETTER WILL BE REQUESTED.
