#### **Charitable Program Services**

#### **Achievements**

#### **Community Capacity Building Programs:**

Rupununi Learners Foundation (RLF) operates in Guyana by supporting Rupununi Learners Inc. (RLI), a Guyanese Nonprofit Corporation with a Board composed of Yupukari Village Residents.

The Purpose of RLI is 1) to manage the interlinked education, research, ecotourism and enterprise activities of Caiman House Field Station (CHFS), and 2) to fulfill a mission of strengthening regional education—specifically by means of library creation in Rupununi communities, based on the model in Yupukari. RLI's library outreach and support activities in 2009 involved placement of books and materials and visits by two salaried Outreach personnel to 7 communities.

2009 saw an expansion of CHFS ecotourism operations to 350+ overnight visitors from 100 in 2008, as well as an increasingly prominent regional role for CHFS, which hosted a Conservation International Community Tourism Conference (70 people for 5 days) as well as meetings of the North Rupununi District Development Board, the Guyana Red Cross, the Mothers union, Guyana Environmental Protection Agency, Guyana Peace Corps, Bina Hill Institute and Guyana Ministry of Health.

Also in 2009 RLF funded the construction of a satellite Volunteer House in Katoka, a village 1 hour by river from yupukari, in anticipation of expanding operations in both educational tourism and in our relationship with the Peace Corp

#### Natural Resource Conservation and Protection

In April 2009, the International union for the Conservation of Nature (IUCN, the conservation of the United nations) became the primary funder of the Black Caiman Research Project, a role that had been filled in 2008 by the Sea World Busch Gardens Conservation Fund. The funding was supplied to RLI in Guyana directly, and expanded our research into three new projects: identifying Important Brd areas, tagging tree species, pit-trapping small herps and amphibians. RLF supplemented the IUCN funding by procuring needed items hard to find in Guyana, and by continuing to underwrite the costs associated with maintaining a foreign volunteer-trainer – his room, board, transportation and expenses – who moved into the Administrator of Research position, having trained a Tourism Manager to a level of independent competence in technology, communications and management.

#### Reading Encouragement Programs

The Yupukari Public Library continued to offer seven-day-a-week service to villagers with 2 librarians on staff, plus a Peace Corps Volunteer as a liason between the village schools and the library. The volunteer lives in housing built and maintained by RLF. Our relationship with Books Beyond Borders (BBB), described in our 2008 report as "Project Schoolhouse", (the name of their nonprofit arm), led to three shipments of children's books, each a full pallet containing approximately 2,000 volumes, to enhance, replace stocks in classroom and village libraries in 8 Rupununi communities. RLF continued to provide school supplies for

Yupukari schools and the Yupukari Public Library afterschool program. We also replaced library laptops and the modem, repaired the data projector, and continued to underwrite Internet service for the entire Field Station.

The Fourth Annual Reading Rodeo was held on December 2, 2009, a village-wide literacy festival sponsored by RLF.

#### **RLF Operations**

The most significant accomplishment (and expense) of RLF in 2009 was associated with a nine-month process of competing for – and ultimately winning – a \$25000 prize in the Social enterprise and Innovation Competition, conferred by the Skandalaris Center for Entrepreneurial Studies within the Olin School of Business at Washington University in St. Louis. The prize was awarded for an innovative business plan to development sustainability for RLI by expanding educational tourism from the US via accreditation. Lesley University in Cambridge, MA has accredited a nine-credit course in Indigenous Knowledge, taught by villagers as a Study Abroad summer term with their Environmental Studies program.

As in prior years when Form 990-EZ and 2006 and 2007 and 2008 when a 990PF was filed, all disbursements are accounted for as Expenses, instead of aggregating to the value of an Asset, for two reasons: 1) Local Law in this region of Guyana does not permit purchase or ownership of land by individuals. All land, and the buildings upon it are owned by the Village Council. Rupununi Learners Foundation does not hold title to the land or the buildings, although it has appropriate agreements about its program and the use of the buildings with the Council. 2) Rupununi Learners Foundation whose main purpose in the area is the development of literacy and access to information does not intend to hold Assets of their own in this area. Rather, it contributes directly to the capacity building process within the Village of Yupukari. The Village Council owns, and will continue to own and operate as its own, all of the resources that the Rupununi Learners Foundation are able to bring to the Community through its presence within the Community. This local ownership and Village participation is a key element in the program strategy of the Foundation.
