During 2009 the Civic Caucus enlarged its list of electronic participants 2,000 individuals. Approximately 40 background papers on public issues, each averaging four single-spaced pages, were distributed via email. The background papers covered mainly the issue areas of problems and possible improvements in government structure and in the elections process The Civic Caucus regularly polled its electronic participants about their feelings on the issues
