<u>Purpose</u>. The Zeron Foundation is a charitable non-profit trust organized under the law of New York and approved as an organization described under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Zeron Foundation focuses its grant making in the following areas:

- 1. Financial aid to high schools and colleges for students based on need and excellence.
- 2. Charities in the Western New York area whose purpose is to improve the health and life of the recipient.

Eligibility. To qualify for a grant, the applicant must be a certified U.S. tax exempt organization whose work falls within the areas outlined above.

<u>Proposals</u>. Proposals in duplicate should be in the form of a letter-limited to four pages and signed by an officer of the organization and should include:

- 1. A brief summary of the history, purpose and goals of the applying organization.
- 2. The specific purpose of the grant and the amount requested.
- 3. Total cost of the specific project.
- 4. Amounts pledged to the specific project from other organizations and, where significant, the names of such other organizations.
- 5. Dates at which funds will be required.

Attachments.

- 1. A copy of the organization's most recent audited financial statement.
- 2. A list of the current directors of the organization.
- 3. A copy of the tax exemption certificate from the Internal Revenue Service.

<u>Deadline</u>. The Board of Trustees of the Zeron Foundation meets in the last week of November each year. The deadline for receipt of proposals to be considered at the next meeting is the 15th of September.

Monitoring. The Foundation requires of all grant recipients:

- 1. Semi-annual progress reports.
- 2. An annual financial accounting of grant disbursements.
