1. Nature of Organization:

Child Protect of Mercer County, Inc. is a nonprofit organization which administers a child-centered facility for child abuse victims and provides service to them and their families while working with the community to prevent such abuse.

2. Significant Accounting Policies:

The accompanying financial statements have been prepared on the accrual basis of accounting with net assets classified as unrestricted, temporarily restricted or permanently restricted based on the existence of donor-imposed restrictions as required by the Statement of Financial Standards No. 117, "Financial Statements of Not-for-Profit Organizations".

Management uses estimates and assumptions in preparing these financial statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles. Actual results could vary from the estimates that were used.

For the purposes of the statement of cash flows, any investments purchased with a maturity of three months or less are considered to be cash equivalents.

3. Property and Equipment:

In 2009, the Organization sold the property and building at South 4th Street, Princeton, West Virginia, recognizing a profit of \$14,701 on the sale. It purchased the building and property at 206 Center Street, Princeton, West Virginia and relocated operations.

The Organization also owns assorted office equipment and furniture. Fixed assets greater than \$1000 are recorded at cost and depreciated on a straight-line basis over an estimated useful life of 39 years for buildings and improvements and 3 years for all other assets.

5. Line of Credit:

The Organization maintains a \$ 12,000 line of credit with First Community Bank of Bluefield, West Virginia secured with a Certificate of Deposit for the same amount. The term of this agreement is one year, expiring October 2010. Interest is calculated at 4%. The balance due as of December 31, 2009 is \$11,500.

6. Mortgage

On March 23, 2009, Child Protect of Mercer County assumed a \$98,166 mortgage to purchase the operating facility located at 206 Center Street, Princeton, WV. Interest is calculated at 6.5%. Payments are \$737.49 per month for 59 with the estimated balance of \$84,880 due on March 23, 2014.

9. Prior Period Adjustment:

Assets purchased and expensed in 2008 were reclassed to property and equipment.

10. Subsequent Events:

Management has evaluated subsequent events through August 25, 2010.

11. Income Taxes:

Child Protect of Mercer County, Inc. is tax exempt under the Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3).
