## Statement 3 - Form 990-EZ, Part III - Organization's Primary Exempt Purpose

### Description

THE CHAPMAN FOUNDATION WAS ORGANIZED TO BENEFIT THE CHILDREN OF PROFESSIONALS IN THE HAIR CARE INDUSTRY. SPECIFICALLY, THE FOUNDATION DESIRES TO ASSIST SUCH PROFESSIONALS WITH THEIR CHILDREN'S EDUCATIONAL EXPENSES THROUGH VARIOUS SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 12TH GRADERS ENTERING COLLEGE OR A SKILLED TRADE. THE FOUNDATION HAS THE GOAL OF GRANTING THREE (3) SCHOLARSHIPS A YEAR TO THOSE STUDENTS MEETING THE ACADEMIC CRITERIA AND FINANCIAL NEED CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS. THE FOUNDATION PLANS TO RAISE FUNDS FOR SUCH SCHOLARSHIPS THROUGH DONATIONS AND AN ANNUAL BEAUTIFUL JAMBOREE FUNDRAISER. FOUNDATION WILL DISTRIBUTE SUCH SCHOLARSHIPS WHEN IT RAISES SUFFICIENT FUNDS. THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE FOUNDATION WILL ESTABLISH THE ACADEMIC/FINANCIAL CRITERIA FOR THE SCHOLARSHIPS, ADMINISTER THE REVIEW OF SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS, AND AWARD SUCH SCHOLARSHIPS.

FURTHER, THE FOUNDATION PLANS TO COLLECT FOOD PRODUCTS AND TOYS FROM THOSE IN THE HAIR CARE INDUSTRY (I.E. AT THE BEAUTIFUL JAMBOREE FUNDRASIER) TO DONATE TO FAMILIES AND CHILDREN WITH FINANCIAL NEEDS. THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE FOUNDATION WILL DETERMINE THE RECIPIENTS OF SUCH DONATIONS BY EVALUATING THEIR LIVING CONDITIONS AND NEEDS, OR THE BOARD WILL DONATE ITEMS TO OTHER NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS TO BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE POOR.

THE FOUNDATION ANTICIPATES THAT 70% OF ITS TIME WILL BE DEDICATED TO THE SCHOLARSHIPS AND 30% OF ITS TIME WILL BE DEDICATED TO THE COLLECTION AND DONATION OF FOOD PRODUCTS AND TOYS FOR THE NEEDY.
