



## **Notes to Financial Statements**

# 1. NATURE OF OPERATIONS AND SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### **Nature of Operations**

The accompanying financial statements of Collectors Foundation (Foundation) have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAP). Management has evaluated subsequent events through the date these financial statements were available to be issued, April 28, 2010.

The Foundation is a public charitable foundation whose mission and principal activities are to receive and administer funds for fostering preservation of, and education about, historic vehicles and vintage boats. The Foundation's revenues and other support are derived principally from contributions, including in-kind contributions, and its activities are conducted throughout the United States. The Foundation intends to provide scholarships and grants to those persons and organizations who work to further the education, preservation and safety of historic vehicles and vintage boats.

#### Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with GAAP requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues, expenses, gains, losses and other changes in net assets during the reporting period. Although the estimates are considered reasonable, actual results could differ from those estimates.

#### Cash and Cash Equivalents

The Foundation considers all liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less to be cash equivalents. At December 31, 2009 and 2008, cash equivalents consisted primarily of money market accounts with a broker.

#### Assets Held for Sale

The Collectors Foundation currently holds a 1950 Lyman boat with an estimated fair market value of \$7,000, and a 1965 Honda motorcycle with an estimated fair market value of \$2,000 as assets held for sale. The Foundation anticipates selling the assets during 2010; as such, the items have been classified as assets held for sale in the accompanying statements of financial position. The difference between the final proceeds received and the carrying value, if any, will be recognized when the items are sold.

## **Notes to Financial Statements**

#### **Contributions**

Gifts of cash and other assets received without donor stipulations are reported as unrestricted revenue and net assets. All contributions received during the years ended December 31, 2009 and 2008 are unrestricted. Gifts received with a donor stipulation, if any, that limits their use are reported as temporarily or permanently restricted revenue and net assets. When a donor-stipulated time restriction ends or purpose restriction is accomplished, temporarily restricted net assets are reclassified to unrestricted net assets and reported in the statements of activities as net assets released from restrictions. Gifts having donor stipulations that are satisfied in the period the gift is received are reported as unrestricted revenue and net assets.

Unconditional gifts expected to be collected within one year are reported at their net realizable value. Unconditional gifts expected to be collected in future years are reported at the present value of estimated future cash flows. The resulting discount is amortized using the level-yield method and is reported as contribution revenue.

Conditional gifts depend on the occurrence of a specified future and uncertain event to bind the potential donor and are recognized as assets and revenue when the conditions are substantially met and the gift becomes unconditional.

#### In-Kind Contributions

In addition to receiving cash contributions, the Foundation receives in-kind contributions from various donors. It is the policy of the Foundation to record the estimated fair value of certain in-kind donations as an expense in its financial statements, and similarly increase contribution revenue by a like amount. For the years ended December 31, 2009 and 2008, \$126,138 and \$127,742, respectively, was recorded as in-kind contributions.

#### Income Taxes

The Foundation is exempt from income taxes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and a similar provision of state law. However, the Foundation is subject to federal income tax on any unrelated business taxable income. Under current IRS rules, exempt organizations must complete their own calculations by the end of their sixth year to determine if public charity status can be retained. The year ended December 31, 2009 marks the end of the fifth year of operations for the Foundation, and calculations will be completed prior to December 31, 2010 in order to determine if it will continue as a public charity or if it must be converted to a private foundation.

The Foundation has not identified any material uncertain tax positions. As such, the disclosures required by GAAP pertaining to uncertain tax positions have been omitted.

#### 2. CONTRIBUTIONS RECEIVABLE

Contributions receivable at December 31, 2009 and 2008 consisted of \$45,921 and \$16,066, respectively, of contributions due within one year. The Foundation believes these contributions receivable are fully collectible and, as such, has not established an allowance for uncollectible contributions receivable. The long-term contributions receivable are due by 2012.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require disclosure of certain significant estimates and current vulnerabilities due to certain concentrations. Those matters include the following:

#### **Contributions**

Approximately 88% and 75% of all contributions was received from for the years ended December 31, 2009 and 2008, respectively.

## 5. CONDITIONAL PROMISES TO GIVE

The Foundation has made a conditional promise to give, whereby the Foundation will match the donee's fundraising amounts on an annual basis up to \$5,000 over three years for a total of \$15,000. The Foundation has paid the recipient three installments of \$5,000 upon meeting the matching requirements. At December 31, 2009, the Foundation has no outstanding conditional promises to give.

The Foundation has made a conditional promise to give, whereby the Foundation will match the donee's fundraising amounts on an annual basis up to \$10,000 over three years for a total of \$30,000. The Foundation has paid the recipient three installments of \$10,000 upon meeting the matching requirements. At December 31, 2009, the Foundation has no outstanding conditional promises to give.
