- 1. Payroll. All of LIFE's payroll is processed by the General Conference of Seventh Day Adventists. Since LIFE is not a General Conference entity, but Adventists-Laymen's Services and Industries (ASI) is a General Conference entity, the General Conference bills ASI for the payroll. LIFE is then billed by ASI for the payroll. LIFE reimburses ASI for the payroll amounts. All of LIFE's employees are listed on the General Conference's form W-3, so LIFE does not file one.
- 2. <u>Contributors</u>. The Larry Sharley Institute of Lay Evangelism (LIFE) was provided for in the After litigation ensued, a Settlement Agreement was entered into and a Court Order was issued. Under those terms, all of the assets of the Trust (related to LIFE), after approved expenses, were transferred to ASI Missions, Inc (ASIMI). ASIMI caused the creation of LIFE. LIFE provides ASIMI with an annual operational plan and budget for its operations along with reports of its activities, operating financial statements and minutes of its Board and Executive Committee meetings. Based upon the information provided to ASIMI by LIFE, funding to assist in LIFE's operations is provided by ASIMI.
- 3. <u>Related Parties</u>. The North American Division of Seventh-Day Adventiests provides credentials for all of LIFE's Ordained Ministers. However, this is more of a service provider, so they are not listed as a related party.
