Guidelines for Proposals

The Kumin Foundation seeks to perpetuate and build on the passions of its founders, with a strong emphasis on Alaska. Areas of interest include the visual arts, music (classical, opera and jazz), education and literacy, wetlands, architecture, rural/urban issues, sailing, cross-country skiing and trails for recreation, homelessness and recognition of the innate dignity and humanity of every person. The Kumin Foundation encourages proposals that reflect synergy, activism and energy. Proposals need to be thoughtful, mindful of their budget, integrate with the goals of your organization and reflect their impact on the organization and the community. We are also interested in any leverage of other funds this grant will provide your organization.

The Kumin Foundation seeks to create opportunities for organizational risk taking, cohesion and expression of cultures and interweaving arts, education, service and recreation. The Foundation may provide funding for up to three years for integrative and ground breaking projects. Extensions may be available depending on progress of the project and funding availability.
