We initiated the movement toward privatized mental health care and serve as a model for future projects in Armenia for the benefit of this vulnerable population.

We provided long-term ongoing support to one individual (former resident) who is living in a nearby clinic through conducting weekly therapeutic visits. We built the capacity of our staff and provided ongoing training to them to ensure that we are providing holistic care to our residents. Training topics in 2009 included: Crisis Management, Behavior Management Plans, Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder, and Emotional Management of Trauma. In the fall of 2009, eleven of our residents were able to begin attending a local university for a special education degree-granting program. Additionally, we continued our in-home programs to encourage the social, physical, mental and vocational well-being of our residents. Through these weekly programs, we facilitated community and societal integration. Individual Care Plans, which include data from the International Classification of Functioning, Disability and Health, continued to serve us and provided quantifiable data in regard to the growth and development of our residents.
