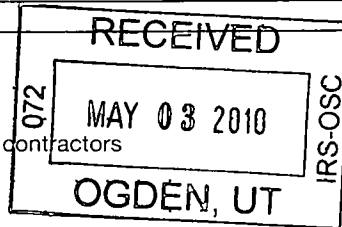

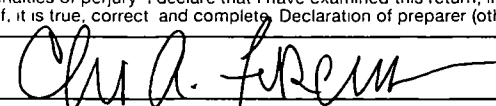

2. ACHIEVEMENTS for 2009

A. Maintain the Christian Student House in Butare, Rwanda (\$ 27510)

CASA maintains a house in Butare, Rwanda, year-round near the National University of Rwanda (NUR). This is our base of operation in Africa. CASA supports this house with about \$2000 per month. This cost covers personnel, rent, supplies, and materials. In addition we support house activities with about \$3000 during each mission to Rwanda. In 2009, there was one mission. These are six Major achievements of the Christian Fellowship house in 2009.

- (1) About 35 NUR students drop by the house daily for counsel, prayer, & study.
- (2) About 16 students per week spend the night in one of two guest rooms at no charge. Many of these visits are overnight prayer sessions.
- (3) There are Bible Study classes held in the house 5 days a week. There are about 124 students over the course of a week.
- (4) In the morning the house is open to local farmers for devotions. There are typically 10 women and 30 children in house between 6 and 7 AM.
- (5) During the June/July Mission Trip, five classes were offered by visiting missionaries based in the house:
 1. A Pastor Seminar (27 local pastors)
 2. A Ladies Seminar (22 women)
 3. A Guitar class (6 students)
 4. A Student Seminar (80 NUR Students)

B. Support of Christian missionaries while in Africa (\$ 1700)

Only two missionaries traveled to Africa with CASA in 2009. Each was supported with \$800 for in and around expenses: mostly food, lodging and transportation. In addition to teaching the four classes listed above in (5)1-4, the missionaries visited orphanages, hospitals, and assisted in some rural development.

C. Constructing a new campus house in Butare, called the *LightHouse* (\$ 36820)

The house is about one-half completed. We build as funds become available and the past year was difficult year for fund-raising. This house is intended to be a resource and refuge for university students.

Statement of Program Service Accomplishments

1. **PURPOSE:** The charitable purpose of Come & See Africa International (CASA) is to provide a structured missionary experience in East Africa. We do this in the following 7 ways:

Recruit: We speak at churches, send out flyers, and advertise in other ways to encourage people to join us on our missions to Africa. (9%)

Equip: We meet with volunteers who are committed to joining us. We do some preparation beforehand in America and some in Africa. We equip them with knowledge and skill for evangelism in Africa. It is a spiritual, physical, and, emotional, mental equipping. If some have an area of expertise (teaching, medical, counseling) we help them to prepare their specific activities. (5%)

Accompany: Most volunteers will travel with us to Entebbe Airport in Uganda. We then are with them the whole time until they return to Entebbe. Most of the volunteers' time is spent in Rwanda, but time may be spent visiting sites in Uganda, Burundi, and Congo.(20%)

Send: Some volunteers will travel unaccompanied to Entebbe Airport in Uganda. We arrange for their travel and other logistics. (1%)

Introduce: We bring volunteers into native churches, orphanages, hospitals, refugee camps, and other places that help the needy of Africa. Our hope is that they make a connection with some organization that they can support upon their return to America. (23%)

Support: We meet all the needs of the volunteers while in Africa. We provide them with food, transportation, and lodging. We also provide interpreters. We maintain a house in Butare, Rwanda, for the express purpose of supporting volunteers. (40%)

Follow up: We keep in touch with all those who have accompanied us to Africa (2%)
