- 2.On January 29, 2010, the organization filed Articles of Amendment with the Pennsylvania Department of State to amend and restate its Articles of Incorporation as the organization's Second Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation ("Second Articles").
- a. The organization's initial Articles of Incorporation were basically from articles filed to begin the organization's existence early on with the most basic purpose of "a ministry for Christian charitable, religious, and educational purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3), . . . primarily in, but not limited to, the greater Philadelphia region . . . to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ . . ."
- b. In the Second Articles, the fundamental purpose of the organization as stated in the organization's initial Articles of Incorporation, remains exactly the same, but is fleshed out with the intent of the Board of Directors of the organization to better formulate the Second Articles in a way that would clearly disclose to everyone who becomes involved with and

supports the organization, including, but not limited to, board members, officers, and donors, that the organization will remain focused on this purpose, as envisioned and formulated by the initial Board of Directors of the organization.

c. In the period of time after the initial Articles of Incorporation were filed with the Pennsylvania Department of State, the Board deliberated over many hours as to how best to ensure that the intent of donors to the organization in accordance with this purpose would be protected from change over time from one generation to the next. The changes in the Second Articles expand upon the purpose by (i) describing in more detail the organization's understanding of what is meant by the Gospel of Jesus Christ (i.e., the traditional protestant reformation understanding) without affiliation with any particular Christian protestant denomination or church, (ii) requiring that Board members agree with and act for the organization in all ways in accordance with that understanding, and (iii) providing for the termination and dissolution of the organization in the event that this purpose and understanding is ever changed or thwarted, with provision in such event for the transfer of the organization's remaining assets to other charitable organizations that are in accordance with the donors' intent. The goal is that the donors' intent at the time of donation will be in accordance with this purpose and will be honored and protected over time consistent with the requirements of applicable law with respect to the such donation.
