The mission of the American Security project (ASP) is to foster knowledge and understanding of a range of national security and foreign policy issues. ASP's efforts will lead to developing and widely disseminating a national security vision and strategy for the 21st century.

Part III, Line 4a: Statement of 2009 Program Service Accomplishments

In the course of 2009, ASP grew and expanded its programming. With the support of individuals, foundations, and corporations, ASP launched studies, events, and initiatives on the fight against terrorists, climate change, energy security and America's defense needs—all priority topics identified by the ASP board of directors.

The Fight against Terrorists

In the last 12 months, ASP has continued its groundbreaking research on the fight against al Qaeda and associated groups. In December, ASP released its third-annual "Are We Winning?" report which again measured progress in the fight against al Qaeda. An AP wire-service story placed the report in more than 1500 news outlets around the country, and led to coverage on CNN and Fox News.

In April 2009, ASP released the mid-year update of "Are We Winning?" which documented a surprising spike in terrorist attacks around the world in the second-half of 2008 and noted the lack of an "Obama-Factor" in public attitudes towards the United States, especially in the Islamic world. Upon its release, ASP Senior Fellow Bernard Finel briefed the findings of this interim assessment to staff of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee and the House Armed Services Committee.

Climate Change and Energy Security

In 2009, ASP launched a multimedia, multi-platform public education campaign on the national security challenges posed by climate change and dependence on foreign energy supplies, particularly foreign petroleum. Highlights of this effort include a September 10, 2009, conference, co-hosted with the George Washington University Elliott School of International Affairs, at which ASP released its comprehensive study of climate, energy, and security, the "Climate Security Index." In addition, ASP continued its innovative use of polling to examine public attitudes to novel security issues by releasing its survey on the public's understanding of climate, energy, and security.

Panelists at the September 10 conference discussed regional security impacts of climate change, as well as the consequences for the U.S. military, economy, and foreign policy. The day featured keynote addresses

by: Senator John Kerry, a member of the ASP board and Chairman of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee; Michael Oppenheimer, a Nobel Prize winning climate scientist at Princeton University; and R. James Woolsey, the former Director of Central Intelligence.

In addition, ASP launched a print and broadcast ad campaign around the issue, and debuted a new website, <u>www.SecureAmericanFuture.org</u>. Video of the September 10 conference, the ads used on television and in print, as well as the "Climate Security Index" are all available on this site.

Finally, because of the organization's work in this topic, ASP President Vice Admiral Lee F. Gunn, USN (Ret.), testified before the Senate Foreign Relations Committee on July 21, 2009.

America's Defense Needs

Over the period of this report, ASP has continued to examine the defense needs of the United States. In late 2008, ASP released an examination of alternative defense plans for the country premised on differing approaches that could have been pursued by the new administration. The series, authored principally by ASP adjunct fellows, described certain assumptions about America's defense budget—the threat level in the world, as well as the public's willingness to maintain record defense spending and global commitments—and then developed alternative force structures for each vision.

To continue the dialogue, ASP has launched a dinner series with the Vice Chiefs of Staff of each of the U.S. armed services. Thus far, we have hosted sessions with General Peter Chiarelli, USA, and General Walter Fraser, USAF. At each session, ASP invites a distinguished group of defense analysts and reporters to participate in a candid, off-the-record conversation.

Over the summer of 2009, ASP Senior Fellow Bernard Finel stoked debate in the corridors of power from Washington to Kabul with a series of important essays online and in print about counter-insurgency and U.S. strategy in Afghanistan. From first-hand accounts we know that his essay, "Doubting Afghanistan," published in *Foreign Policy*, was reviewed by members of General Stanley McChrystal's staff in Afghanistan.

Iraq Uncensored

Over the last 18 months, ASP asked nearly 30 prominent Americans one simple question: "What is the single most important lesson the United States should learn from the Iraq War?" The responses we received from politicians, scholars, government officials who served at critical points in the war, and leaders in religion and business, were published in August 2009 in *Iraq Uncensored*, (Fulcrum Publishing) edited by James M. Ludes, ASP Executive Director.
