		Part VI, Line 11a - Describe the process used by the organization to review this form Sgt Pfifer, the Treasurer/Secretary provides a copy to the sheriff, who is the Chairman of the board, and also e-mails the other four members of the board that the tax return is available in the sheriff's office for review. Also, since this is an annual event in a small town, most of the information is already well known through newspaper coverage and the Sheriff's Office website. For example, within six weeks of the 2009 ride, all of the money distributed to the 501(c)(3) charities was accomplished, at which time the news was posted on the sheriff's website. Part VI, Line 19 - How does the board make its governing documents, conflict of interest policy and financial statements available to the public? The board does not have a separate conflict of interest policy, but uses the one that the county has adopted. The policy for the county is at the county courthouse if the public wants to look at it. The governing documents of the board and the tax return are available at the Sheriff's Office for review by the public. Other than checkbook, there are no financial statements. The activity of the annual ride encompasses more logistic than financial effort. For example, the 2010 ride caused 18 checks to be written, which included the 6 checks for the money given to the 501(c)(3) charities. In summary, the planning activities usually go on for 4 to 6 months, while the financial activity continues on and off for about 12 weeks.
