

- (1.) On the 990, page 3, Part IV, Line 12 the question should have been answered no as the organization had a review of the Books and not an Audit. Originally there had been a schedule D attached. The figures from the schedule D on the original return were from the Review of the Books. Since this question should have been answered no there was not a need to complete a schedule D.
- (2.) On the 990, page 9, Part VIII, Line 1.g the amount of non-cash contributions was listed incorrectly and should have shown the amount of \$26,925.00. On the 990, Page 4, Part IV, Line 29 should have been answered yes the non-cash contributions did exceed FMV of \$25,000.00. This also created a need for a schedule M since the non-cash contributions were over \$25,000.00. The Schedule M is attached.
- (3.) On the 990, page 12, Part XI, line 2 b the answer should have been no as the Books of the organization were reviewed and not audited.
- (4.) On Schedule B, Part I the Copntributors #7, #32 and #42 all gave only non-cash contributions. This has been corrected on Part I and they all have been listed on Part II with the correct information.
