THE MAC MARTIN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Mac Martin Foundation has created and will offer scholarships to area high school graduates.

By offering these scholarships The Mac Martin Foundation demonstrates its support for area young people and their future in the Fairfield, Illinois, area. The purpose of the scholarships are to create an opportunity for the recipients to attend college who might not otherwise have attended.

The criteria for becoming a scholarship recipient are:

- 1. The student must be in the current graduating class of a Fairfield Community High School.
- 2. The student must have a minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale or the equivalent.
- 3. The student must have an ACT or SAT score.
- 4. The student must be active in school and participate annually in two sports.
- 5. The student must pursue a degree at an accredited university, college or community college, and must attend an education institution as defined in the Internal Revenue Code Section 170(b)(1)(A)(ii).
- 6. Each applicant must provide a written request for consideration.

- 7. Documents submitted with the application must include the following:
 - (a) The High School Transcript and copy of ACT/SAT score.
 - (b) Three letters of recommendation from persons who are not related to the student.
 - (c) List of sport activities participated in.
 - (d) List of awards received and associations participated in.
 - (e) Goals and objectives of the student and how they coincide with the proposed degree objectives.

The student should apply through his/her high school counseling office.

The number and amount of the scholarships will be determined by the Advisory Committee of The Foundation and will be disbursed in two increments annually.

The recipients must maintain a 2.5 G.P.A. on a 4.0 scale and remain a full-time student as classified by the school to receive second semester and subsequent awards.

The recipients must prove enrollment as a full-time student at such school prior to receipt of the initial scholarship funds. Prior to subsequent disbursements, the recipient must provide a certified copy of transcript documenting enrollment and grade point average which meets scholarship standards.

The recipients must provide supporting documentation such as invoices for tuition, books or room and board to prove scholarship funds were used as intended. If funds are determined to be used for purposes other than intended, recipients will be pursued by whatever lawful means necessary to recover scholarship funds.

Disbursements of scholarship funds will be made directly to the school that the recipient is attending except the foundation at its discretion may reimburse a student on a direct basis for qualifying educational expenses.
