Substantial Contraction

During the taxable year ending December 31, 2009, The Neda Foundation (the "Foundation) made distributions from sources other than current income. Collectively, the distributions in excess of current income totaled \$170,000. This amount represents over 25% of the Foundation's net assets of \$159,522 (as measured by fair market value) at the beginning of the Foundation's taxable year ending December 31, 2009. Although the Foundation technically experienced a "substantial contraction," it will continue in existence and has no plans for dissolution.
