The EDF Committee will be comprised of the medical center employees, with a majority of the members being in a non-management position. To be eligible for assistance, applicants must meet certain criteria as specified in the EDF Policy. The EDF Committee will examine the circumstances and merits of each case in accordance with the intent if the EDF policy. Awards may take the form of grants or loans. Substantial, ongoing requests made by the same employee, are beyond the purpose and capabilities of the EDF. Therefore the following limitations apply to employees making multiple requests for assistance. I Employees may receive a maximum of two loans per rolling tweleve month period, 2. Maximum outstanding loan balance at any time cannot exceed \$500,3. Maximum amount of all assistance from the EDF (grants and loans) cannot exceed \$1,000 during any rolling 18 month period, 4. Minumum loan repayment is \$20.00 per pay period. Repayment is expected upon termination of employment. However, in its sole discretion, the EDF Committee may adjust repayment terms by majority action at its next regular meeting. The EDF Committee shall maintain complete and accurate minutes and records of its proceedings. These shall include a minimum, but without limitation, a complete description of any assistance provided, the purpose for which the aid was given, the objective criteria used for disbursing assistance, how recipients were selected, and the name, address and amount distributed to each recipient. A Health Career Scholarship that will be administered by a committee made up of Mrs Komaromi, R. Davis Cutting, a representative from the Board of Directors and a member of the administrative team. This group will identify specific areas each year in the hospital which are experiencing or anticipating recruitment d
