

**NOTE A - DESCRIPTION OF BUSINESS AND SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT  
ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

*Organization*

The Interstate Realty Management Company Educational Foundation (Foundation) was formed on March 27, 1991, under the nonprofit corporation law of Pennsylvania.

The Foundation's purpose is to solicit contributions and award scholarships to residents and their children whose primary residence is with a parent or guardian residing on a site which is professionally managed by Interstate Realty Management Company. The criteria used to select scholarship recipients includes academic performance, character, and proficiency and/or potential in a chosen field of study. The Foundation sponsors an annual golf tournament, the Annual Golf Classic, to raise funds.

Beginning in 2008, Michael J. Levitt implemented the Michaels Employees Scholarship Program. The Program's purpose is to award scholarships to dependent children of any fulltime employee below senior level management, of any of the companies within the Michaels Organization. The criteria used to select scholarship recipients includes academic performances, character, and proficiency and/or potential in a chosen field of study. The Michaels Employees Scholarship Program is a privately-funded program sponsored solely by Michael J. Levitt.

*Estimates*

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenue and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

*Cash and cash equivalents*

The Foundation maintains its cash in bank deposit accounts which, at times, may exceed federally insured limits. The Foundation has not experienced any losses in such accounts. The Foundation believes it is not exposed to any significant credit risk on cash and cash equivalents.

For purposes of the statement of cash flows, the Foundation considers all highly liquid debt instruments purchased with an initial maturity of three months or less to be cash equivalents.

*Income taxes*

The Foundation is exempt from Federal income taxes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and is treated as a publicly supported organization.

On January 1, 2009, the Foundation adopted the new accounting standard related to uncertainty in income taxes. For the year ended December 31, 2009, the Foundation did not identify any uncertain tax positions taken or expected to be taken in an income tax return which would require adjustment to or disclosure in its financial statements. In addition, the Foundation believes it has not engaged in any activities for which its tax-exempt status would not be sustained under Internal Revenue Service examination. Generally, the Foundation is potentially not subject to Federal income tax examinations for years before 2006.

*Contributions*

In accordance with SFAS No. 116, contributions received are recorded as unrestricted, temporarily restricted or permanently restricted depending on the existence and/or nature of any donor restrictions.

Contributions, which include unconditional promises to give, are recognized as revenue in the period the contribution is received. Contributions that are not restricted by the donor are recorded as increases in unrestricted net assets. Contributions that are restricted by the donor are reported as increases in unrestricted net assets if the restrictions expire within the fiscal year in which the contributions are recognized. Other contributions are recorded as temporarily restricted or permanently restricted net assets depending upon the nature of the donor restrictions. When a restriction expires, temporarily restricted net assets are transferred to unrestricted net assets.

At December 31, 2009, the Foundation did not have temporarily or permanently restricted net assets.

*Concentrations*

Approximately 80% of the contributions to the Foundation were from Michael J. and Patricia Levitt.

*Subsequent events*

The Foundation has evaluated subsequent events through July 28, 2010, which is the date its financial statements were available to be issued.

**NOTE B - CONTRIBUTION MATCHING AND RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS**

Effective January 1, 1992, Michael J. Levitt, President of the Foundation and Patricia Levitt, Director of the Foundation, have promised to personally match all individual contributions made to the Foundation. Beginning in 2003, the Levitts promised to double their matching contributions for the resident scholarship program.

In 2009, Michael J. Levitt, President of the Foundation, contributed \$60,000 towards the Michaels Employees Scholarship Program. Michael J. Levitt's contribution for the employee scholarships is determined based on the total employee scholarships awarded for that particular year.

Contribution revenue includes \$170,759 contributed by the Levitts. The \$16,930 contribution receivable at December 31, 2009 is also due from Mr. and Mrs. Levitt. It is expected to be collected within one year.

Interstate Realty Management Company is controlled by Michael J. Levitt.

At December 31, 2008, Interstate Realty Management Company owed the Foundation \$6,097 for expense reimbursements. The balance was repaid in 2009.

**NOTE C - CONTRIBUTED SERVICES**

Contribution revenue includes \$11,945 for contributed audit services.

All administrative and bookkeeping services to the Foundation are provided by Interstate Realty Management Company. During the year ended December 31, 2009, the value of the contributed services was not material and has not been recorded.


