We have audited the balance sheet (Part X) of Stew Leonard III Children's Charities, Inc. (a Connecticut not-for-profit organization) as of December 31, 2009, and the related statement of revenues (Part VIII) and statement of functional expenses (Part IX) for the year then ended included in the accompanying Internal Revenue Service Form 990 for 2009. These financial statements are the responsibility of the Organization's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

As described in note 1, these financial statements included in Form 990 were prepared in conformity with the accounting practices prescribed by the Internal Revenue Service and State of Connecticut Department of Consumer Protection, which is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than generally accepted accounting principles.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

NOTE 1 - Basis of accounting

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The policy of Stew Leonard III Children's Charities, Inc. (Organization) is to prepare its financial statements on the accrual basis of accounting: consequently, certain revenues are recognized when earned, and certain expenses and purchases of assets are recognized when the obligation is incurred.

These financial statements were prepared in conformity with the accounting practices prescribed by the Internal Revenue Service and the State of Connecticut Department of Consumer Protection, which is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than generally accepted accounting principles.

NOTE 2 - Summary of significant accounting policies

Nature of Organization -

Stew Leonard III Children's Charities, Inc. (the Organization) is a not-for-profit organization that was incorporated in Connecticut in 1990 and designed to provide financial support relating to the public promotion of safe and responsible growth and development in kids through nutritional awareness and water safety. Revenues are derived principally from contributions.

Support of the Organization -

The Organization's activities are funded by contributions and grants from foundations, corporations and individuals, and by income earned from investments. All support is recorded as an increase in unrestricted net assets unless specifically restricted by the donor.

Contributions received and promises to give are measured at their fair values and are reported as an increase in net assets. The Organization reports gifts of cash and other assets as restricted support if they are received with donor stipulations that limit the use of the donated assets. When a donor restriction expires, that is when a purpose restriction is met, temporarily restricted net assets are reclassified to unrestricted net assets. Donor-restricted contributions whose restrictions are met in the same reporting period are reported as unrestricted support. Fundraising revenue from special events may be temporarily restricted which restrictions can be met by actions of the Organization or which expire by the passage of time.

Expenses are recorded when incurred in accordance with the accrual basis of accounting.

Fundraising -

Fundraising revenue includes gross receipts from the sale of tickets for The Organization's annual golf tournament, raffle and food and wine tasting events less related expenses.

NOTE 2 - Summary of significant accounting policies (con't)

Donated Materials and Services -

No amounts have been reflected in the financial statements for donated materials and services since no objective basis is available to measure the value of such materials and services. Nevertheless, a substantial number of volunteers have donated hours to the Organization's program services and fund-raising campaigns during the year. These services do not require specialized skills.

Cash and Cash Equivalents -

Cash and cash equivalents consist of cash held in checking accounts, cash invested in money market funds and U.S Treasury Obligations with maturities of three months or less.

Investment Securities -

Investments in marketable securities with readily determinable fair values and all investments in debt securities are valued at their fair values in the statement of financial position. Unrealized gains and losses are included in the change in net assets.

Estimates-

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with the basis of accounting referred to in Note 1 requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reported period.

Conditional promises to give -

Conditional promises to give are recognized only when conditions on which they depend are substantially met and the promises become unconditional. Unconditional promises to give are recognized as revenues or gains in the period received and as assets, decreases in liabilities, or expenses depending on the form of benefits received.

Income taxes –

The Organization is a not-for-profit corporation whose revenue is derived from contributions and other fund-raising activities and is exempt from federal income taxes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Advertising -

Advertising costs are expensed as incurred.

<u>Subsequent events – </u>

Management has evaluated subsequent events through August 9, 2010, the date on which the financial statements were available to be issued.

NOTE 4 - Functional allocation of expenses

The costs of providing the various programs, fund-raising and other activities have been summarized on a functional basis in the statement of functional expenses (Part IX). Accordingly, certain costs have been allocated among the programs and fund-raising activities benefited.

NOTE 5 - Conditional promises to give

As of December 31, 2009 the Organization had received no conditional promises to give.

NOTE 6 - Concentration of credit risk

Cash and cash equivalents are maintained at high-quality financial institutions and credit exposure is limited to any one institution. The Organization has not experienced any losses on its cash equivalents. The Organization's investments do not represent significant concentrations of market risk in as much as the Organization's investment portfolio is in high grade corporate banks, government bonds and preferred stocks.

Throughout the year, the Organization may maintain cash in excess of \$250,000 on deposit in individual banks. The Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) insures only the first \$250,000 of funds at member banks.

NOTE 7 - Related party transactions

The Organization sells certain fund raising merchandise to a company controlled by the president of the Organization and members of his family.
