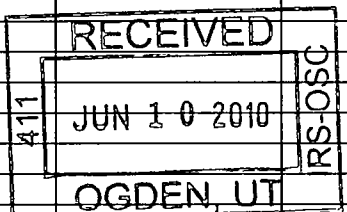

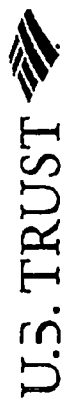

However, we have not made adjustments to the cost basis of all partnerships.

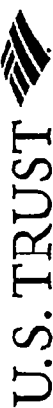
