

Please note that the Independence Foundation's funding area is restricted to Philadelphia and its surrounding Pennsylvania counties: Bucks, Chester, Delaware and Montgomery.

Letters of Inquiry will be reviewed for consistency with current funding priorities. It is impossible for the staff of the Independence Foundation to grant personal interviews to all prospective grantees. Should the original application, after review by the Board of Directors, prove to be within the scope of the Foundation's interests, the applicant will be advised and the necessary interviews may be arranged prior to a final determination by the Board of Directors.
