



DONATION AGREEMENT

By and between:

- 1 **Schlumberger Foundation**, a foundation organized under the laws of Delaware, USA, with its registered address at c/o National Registered Agents Inc, 9 East Loockerman Street, Dover DE19901, USA, , hereinafter referred to as: "Donor";
- 2 **Schlumberger Stichting Fund**, a foundation organized under the laws of the Netherlands with a mailing address at Parkstraat 83, 2514 JG Den Haag, The Netherlands, hereinafter referred to as "Donee";

WHEREAS:

- Donor wishes to donate on or about 15 July 2009 free of charge to Donee the total amount of USD 7.835.000 (seven million eight hundred thirty five thousand US American Dollars) (the "Donation"); and
- The Donation shall be subject to certain requirements as set out in this Donation Agreement.

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED as follows:

1. Donation

- 1.1 Donor hereby donates free of charge an amount of USD 7.835.000 (seven million eight hundred thirty five thousand US American Dollars) (the "Donation") to the Donee and the Donee hereby accepts this amount.
- 1.2 The Donation shall consist of a Qualifying Distribution Portion of USD 400.000 (four hundred thousand US American Dollars) and a Capital Endowment Portion of the remainder, thus USD 7.435.000 (seven million four hundred thirty five thousand US American Dollars)
- 1.3 For the purpose of this Donation Agreement, the term "Donation" shall include income derived from the Donation.
- 1.4 The purpose and the distribution of the Donation shall be subject to the terms and conditions of this Donation Agreement.

2. Purpose

The purpose of the Capital Endowment Portion of the Donation is capital endowment, and the purpose of the Qualifying Distribution Portion of the Donation is a general purpose grant to Donee to be used for the Donee's scientific, educational or charitable purposes.

3. Conditions and Duties

- 3.1 Donee agrees to use the Donation only for scientific, educational and/or charitable purposes and in line with its Articles of Association
- 3.2 Donee further agrees not to use the Qualifying Distribution Portion for any purposes other than those stated in Section 170(c)(2)(B) of the United States Internal Revenue Code (as amended from time to time) as attached to this Donation Agreement as **Schedule 1**.
- 3.3 Donee further agrees not to use the Donation in a way that would constitute a taxable expenditure substantially equivalent to the definitions in Section 4945 (d)(1) through (5) of the United States Internal Revenue Code (as amended from time to time) as attached to this Donation Agreement as **Schedule 2**.
- 3.4 Donee further agrees to make a distribution to a recipient organization(s) at least equal to the Qualifying Distribution Portion before 31 December 2010, and that such distribution will be treated by Donee as a distribution out of corpus as defined in sections 4942 (g) (3) and 4942(h) of the Internal Revenue Code as amended from time to time and attached hereto as **Schedule 3**
- 3.5 Donee agrees that the recipient organization(s) for the Qualifying Distribution Portion as well as for the distribution referred to in section 3.4 of this Donation Agreement will not be under common control, directly or indirectly, with the Donor or Donee.
- 3.6 Donee further agrees to repay to Donor any funds not used for the purpose of this Donation as defined in sections 2 and 3 of this Donation Agreement.
- 3.7 Donee further agrees not to use any of the grant funds for lobbying purposes or to influence legislation.


