


Share, Inc. operates on a July to June fiscal year. In June of each year, Share removes from its accounting records all outstanding checks more than a year old. In doing so this past June, the net asset balance was increased by the amount of those voided checks that were issued prior to December 31, 2008. Therefore, the \$203,130.83 beginning balance was increased by \$1,000.23. Also, in January of this year, a \$400 family assistance check issued in November 2009 was returned to Share uncashed. Voiding this check added another \$400 to the net asset balance. Thus, in addition to the excess shown in item 18, the balance was increased by a total of \$1,400.23.
