medicine.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, line 11: The 990 is submitted to the executive committee for review. This committee consists of the president, vie president, secretary, treasurer, and executive director.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 12c: Conflict of interest within the scope of the role of the organization would relate to equipment design, grant funding, or enforcement of license fee payments. Consequently, the potential for conflict is quite narrow, and easily monitored when those issues come up for discussion. Additionally, the organization requires that all grant applicants disclose any potential conflicts of interest in the grant approval process. This is the area which presents the greatest chance of signficant conflict of interest. This is also the area which is most easily monitored, since the company can solicit conflict input from both the applicant and from the board.
