



2009 Accomplishments

Our Mission: To increase the organized capacity of people in Warren County to care for one another by coordinating individuals, organizations, and resources to efficiently and effectively address human service needs.

1. Actively supported and participated in community collaborations and initiatives that promote safe and healthy communities by creating positive and permanent changes in social service conditions. By working together to leverage time, talent and resources these networks are able to reach more groups and individuals in need. These collaborations included:
 - a. Warren County United to End Family Violence – an initiative involving social service agencies and community volunteers collectively working toward prevention through awareness of domestic violence and its affects, both physical and emotional, on its victims and children who witness it.
 - b. Diversity Council – offered assistance to local schools and businesses by offering grants to educate and promote the importance of awareness and respect for diversity in our community, such as race, religion, economic situation, gender, etc.
 - c. Support and Outreach Committee, Family & Children First Council – promoted the 2008 Update of the Report to the Community, an overview of the social and physical health to identify the trends and needs of Warren County.  - d. Warren County Housing Coalition – collaborated with partner and non-partner agencies to mobilize a homeless shelter for individuals in Warren County.
 - e. Board and staff member representation on committees such as the Warren County Ex-Offender Re-Entry Collaborative, Warren Educational and College Access Network (WECAN) and the Homeless Shelter Coalition for Warren County, and the new Multi-Agency Collaborative on Corrections (MACC).
2. General Joseph Warren Society is a leadership society developed to recognize donors at specific levels, in the hope that their generosity will encourage their peers to meet the challenge of support the Warren County United Way. Members of this society help generate awareness of the social needs in our community. In 2009, the leadership roster continued to grow.
3. Mobilized over 200 volunteers as Account Managers and Employee Campaign Coordinators to assist with our annual fundraising campaign.
4. The Allocation Committee, made up of 38 volunteers, provided leadership and dedication by determining the distribution of funds raised during the Fall Fundraising Campaign. They not only provide the crucial service of determining

membership eligibility and recommendations, they also conduct annual Partner Agency Evaluations. With information obtained during onsite visits and assessments of financial documentation, the committee members ascertain the realistic financial needs of each program.

5. In an effort to provide financial transparency to the community, other United Ways and partner agencies, Warren County United Way placed its IRS Form 990 and Audited Financial Statements on our website available for public viewing.
6. Collaborated with local government agencies and outreach programs to administer a county food drive during the month of December.
7. Obtained 300 complimentary Paramount's Kings Island tickets for volunteers who worked on the 2009 campaign. This positively impacts our volunteer recruitment and builds community and business commitment to our fundraising efforts.
8. Received a significant in-kind donation of blankets, comforters, and pillows from the Down Lite Corporation which were distributed to our partner agencies who could make use of these valuable items in supporting their clients.
