Among other things, travel for companions were provided to compensate for the hardship that extended absence of a staff member implies for his/her family;

and the principal means of satisfying these considerations is through authorized dependent travel awards. Travel points" are the basis for cash travel awards,

which are to be used by the family as defined below. Travel points accrue to staff when they are away from their assigned post on official business, unaccompanied

by anyone from the nuclear family. This includes travel within the country of assignment but does not include home leave, study leave, or compassionate leave

travel. The policy assumes that the nuclear family member is in residence, but not necessarily present, at base while the staff member is travelling.

Tax indemnification and gross-up payments

CIMMYT provides partial tax equalization benefits to international staff whose home governments assess income tax on salaries paid by CIMMYT and on CIMMYT

allowances reported as income and thus subject to taxation

Housing allowance or residence for personal use

Staff based in Mexico: CIMMYT reimburses 75% of rent and 75% of utility charges (for example, gas, electricity, water) - this is subject to pre-set up maximum limit

Staff posted outside of Mexico: For international staff posted outside of Mexico, it is CIMMYT's policy to provide housing, major appliances, and other hard furnishings

and utilities without charge, or to reimburse these costs within agreed limits. The method by which this is achieved varies by location. There will always be additional

costs for staff who wish to acquire house accessories that conform more closely to their own taste in furnishings, and staff will incur operating costs as well.
