# ST JOHN UNITED WAY COMMUNITY IMPACT REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2009

St John United Way is a leader, partner and broker of hope for understanding human service needs across the region, identifying best practices, and bringing together the people and resources to make a difference. We're about positive change in people's lives, not just for today, but also for the long-term. We're about building a stronger, safer, healthier, and more sustainable St John community.

The year 2009 was the fourth year post-Katrina. To best describe the challenges and the mindset of the Board to address these challenges, it may be necessary that we insert part of our 2005 Community impact statement here: "... It was clear to us that it would be a long road to recovery. Our emphasis was on insuring the survival of our agencies, many of which were housed in and around Greater New Orleans. The Board authorized continued funding regardless of status in an effort to salvage a proven resource rather than try to recreate it 2 years later." Three years post Katrina finds St John with 99% of agencies operating at or near pre-Katrina levels and three new agencies to provide services in our highest priority area-Strong Families and Successful Children. Additionally the St. John United Way Board set aside funds to be used to bring in new programs that could provide "High Need" services to address our Community Impact identified needs. Studies have shown that areas impacted by major trauma events like Katrina, the resulting issues can take 5-10 years post event to demonstrate.

St John United Way's programs, partner agencies, and collaborative efforts have made a difference in thousands of lives in the St John community. Our "Safety Net" agencies have provided food, clothing, medicine, temporary housing, utilities, mortgage payments, and transportation to numerous children and families. Our "Health and Independence" agencies have provided wellness and detection education, home meal delivery, medical appliances, medicines, adult day care, weatherization of homes, handicap ramps, therapeutic sessions, and counseling services. Our "Strong Children" and "Successful Families" agencies continued to make inroads to empower our youth and families. Our initiatives in scouting, 4-H, domestic violence, anger management, bullying abatement, group and individual counseling, and literacy included both traditional and innovative projects.

In 2009, St John United Way Board Members conducted an organizational "self assessment" in a continuing effort to improve its operational efficiency and effectiveness. Board Members also participated in a strategic planning session. The session was facilitated by Louisiana Association of United Ways staff. This process helps assure that St John United Way stays focused on its core mission of quality services to the St John community.

We would like to highlight some of the more non-traditional efforts. Examples include:

Throughout the 2009 year, the newer SJUW agencies (River Region YMCA, Big Brothers/Big Sisters of SE LA, and Kingsley House "Truancy Abatement Program) continued to expand their services and partnerships in the St John community

River Region YMCA developed a "Leaders Camp" in partnership with St John Parish Schools and New Wine Christian Center. The camp served 198 St John teens in areas of Leadership Skills, weekly field trips to places outside St John, and service opportunities. Ten teens from St John also attended Chris Paul's 3 day basketball camp thanks to a YMCA grant. The St John YMCA Leaders Club also attended Blue Ridge Leaders School in Black Mountain, North Carolina. During this week, the four leaders from St John attended a wide range of classes from Science and Fitness, Basic Leadership, Beginner to Advance Swimming, and host of other classes. These classes just didn't teach them what they needed to survive in life, but it taught them how to work as a team member to accomplish more.

SJUW partnered with the St John Sheriff's Office, St John School Board and YMCA Educational Services to fund the St John Correctional Center Inmate GED Class. By improving the educational functioning and thus the employability of inmates, we hope to reduce the number returning to crime. St

John United Way was instrumental in securing the efforts of the local Workforce Investment Board to provide workshops on job interview skills, completion of resumes, and other skills necessary for more successful job hunting outcomes. This is part of our "Violence Prevention Initiative; and

In the area of Education, SJUW participated in the first Regional Louisiana's Promise summit at Nichols State in Thibodaux. The purpose was to develop effective district plans to address truancy and improve future graduation rates. The St John committee met several times in 2009, and made steps to address several areas of concern.

On August 4, 2009 a Community Coalition led by St John United Way made a public announcement regarding Truancy in St John Parish. St John United Way because of its standing in the community was able to bring together Parish Leaders that included: St John Parish President's Office, Parish Council, District Attorney's Office, St John Sheriff's Office, the three Judges of the 40<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court, St John Parish Youth Services Planning Board, River Parish Chamber of Commerce, St John Business Association, Marathon Petroleum, LLC, River Parish Education Initiatives, Rotary Club of LaPlace, West Bank Civic Association, and others in an attempt to re-frame the St John Community's concept of Truancy. For too long, truancy as been considered a "school system" problem. In reality, truancy is first and foremost a "quality of life" issue. Communities with undereducated citizens normally have a higher crime rate, a weaker economy, an undertrained workforce, and are therefore not a preferred location for business and industry. It also leads to a reduction in tax collections, business/industry re-locations or reductions, reduced property values, and exodus of upper income citizenry. Truancy is but a symptom of a much larger problem. The message is "Every Child, At School, Every Day". Teachers can't teach and children can't learn unless children are in school. With a truancy rate of 18%, and a dropout rate of 9.4% (3.1 point higher than the state average, it is no wonder that our "on time graduation rate" is at 65.9% which is 14.1 points below the state average.

We are proud of these and all of the other achievements of 2009. We believe that by offering a broad spectrum of services we can better achieve our goal of building a stronger, safer, healthier, and more sustainable St John community.
