Part III Statement of Program Service Accomplishments

The organization's primary exempt purpose is the beautification of New London, NH by planting flowers and shrubs in the public areas of town. Also, it cooperates with other interested agencies to protect and perpetuate desirable plants, to promote and encourage a knowledge and love of gardening, horticulture and flower arranging, and to stimulate an interest in people to work with and for nature.

Line 28) Civic Beautification - Each year, the members of the Club plant and maintain flowers and shrubs in 15 public areas in town. AMENDMENT TO THE NEW LONDON GARDEN CLUB BYLAWS

September 8, 2009 Approved by the Membership

Article IV Officers

Section 2. Delete. Replace with:

"The Nominating Committee shall present a slate of candidates to the voting membership at least one month prior to the September general meeting. The officers shall be elected at the September general meeting by a majority vote of eligible voters present at the meeting."

Section 4. Add: *...commencing on January 1.* at the end of the first sentence.
