Explanation of how the organization determines which individuals receive grants: The ACS Division of Computers in Chemistry (COMP) currently administers the Chemical Computing Group (CCG) Excellence Award, which is given to up to ten graduate students per year in the field of Computational Chemistry on the basis of three criteria: 1) The students must be presenting a poster or oral presentation within the COMP program at an ACS National meeting, 2) the merit of the work to be presented must be very high as judged by a committee selected by the ACS COMP Division Executive Committee, and 3) a letter of recommendation by their thesis advisor must be strong. Applicants are prioritized according to the selection criteria, and up to ten awards may be made each year. The Division also gives one award for Emerging Technologies in Computational Chemistry (Symposium Competition Award), and eight Junior Faculty Excellence Awards. The Emerging Technologies competition award is given on the basis of excellence of research and the presentation of that research during the symposium, which is held at the Fall ACS National Meeting each year. The eight Junior Faculty Awardees (four per meeting) are awarded on the basis of their being tenure-track, junior faculty with excellent emerging research programs as determined by a panel of judges selected by the Executive Committee of the ACS Division of Computers in Chemistry. The ACS Computers in Chemistry Division does not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, sex, physical disability or sexual orientation.

#### Part III
