Catheter infection is one of the major causes of morbidity and mortality in ESRD patients with infections being the second most common cause of death Prevention of catheter infection is pivotal in improving outcomes in this patient population. A randomized, controlled clinical trial to compare two different catheter lock solutions in HD patients with permanent central venous catheters has just been finished and resulted in changes in routine care in all centers. Malnutrition is a known risk factor in patients with ESRD. Protein supplementation is assumed to counteract this disorder, but optimal treatment options are still missing. A randomized controlled trial in patients with low albumin levels has been conducted in patients undergoing peritoneal dialysis or hemodialysis. Patients are given a protein supplement on dialysis or daily in order to test the hypothesis that protein supplementation can improve nutritional status in these patients. The study will be finished at the end of 2009 and data are expected in early 2010 Hypertension and fluid overload are a major problem in patients undergoing hemodialysis. The intradialytic weight gain is thought to be directly influencing both blood pressure and the adverse events occurring during dialysis therapies. The importance of salt intake is well recognized in this respect, however the emphasis has always focused on the salt intake by patients when not on dialysis.
