Bible translation, literacy, and related mobilization and discipleship activities.
PBT teams around the world are ministering to 19 million people in 49 different language projects. Over the last year, PBT personnel processed over 250,000 verses of Scripture from one stage of the translation process to the next. This includes rough drafts, exegetical check, comprehension check, peer check, consultant check, published, and revised. The number of translation projects close to completing the New Testament continues to grow steadily. Five are now in their final stages. In addition, numerous different literacy titles were published in 2009 in multiple languages. Training seminars and workshops were held for national translators on three of PBT's fields. Many individual books of the Bible were also published and distributed in 2009.

Recruitment and training activities.
Recruitment: Recruiting new missionaries is key to the mission of PBT. The organization had 30 new recruits in 2009. PBT held thirty-two different recruitment events at colleges, churches, and other venues around the U.S. Through those events, about 6,000 people became aware of the need for missionaries around the world and specifically opportunities with PBT. About 400 of those are serious inquirers.
Training: Training new and current missionaries is an integral part of PBT's mission. IN 2009, personal and professional coaching was provided to 65 individuals preparing for cross-cultural work. Six intensive training courses were taught twice. These focused on learning language and living cross-culturally. Weekly chapel services were conducted throughout the year. The following workshops and seminars were provided, training over 300 people during the year: Pioneer Missions Institute, Partnership Development, Bush Mechanics and Electronics, Primary Health Care, Team Building, Peacemakers, and Strategic Program Planning. Ongoing training activities continued daily with new recruits and missionaries in training.

Missionary Care
PBT's ministry has a strong missionary care component. During the year, missionary care team members made 8 trips overseas to minister to missionary families. Care packages were sent to 56 missionaries, professional spiritual counseling was provided to 88 missionaries. Hospitality services were provided to 180 missionaries. The missionary care team spearheaded PBT's extensive prayer ministry, involving hundreds of missionaries and supporters. This included prayer walks, prayer and fasting events, and three prayer tools written and distributed to over 1,200 people each month. The team managed the re-entry fund ministering to eighteen individuals returning to US culture. And they organized the following related programs: missionary care conferences, training on missionary care, critical incident debriefings, pastoral debriefings, and numerous chapel programs.


