The Foundation generally will not make grants to organizations that are based outside of the Greater Philadelphia Region.

#### APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The Foundation will only consider requests from qualified tax-exempt, non-profit 501(c)(3) organizations. Applications may be submitted at any time and should include the following:

A brief letter (2-3 pages) that includes:

- A description of the organization and its mission
- Amount of grant request
- A description of the project for which funds are being requested (if the request is for operating or annual support, please provide a general description of the organization's ongoing activities).

Applicants are also asked to append the following:

- If the grant request is for a project or program, please provide the total project budget
- The organization's current operating budget
- A list of the organization's Board of Directors and their professional affiliations

- A copy of the organization's 501(c)(3) determination letter
- The organization may also include <u>one</u> publication or brochure of their choice (no CD's or videos)

Applications should be mailed to:

The Trustees will review each request, and if further information is required, the Foundation will contact the applicant to request additional information or to arrange a site visit. Most funding decisions will be made within six months. The Foundation is not able to provide notification to every applicant, and therefore will only notify applicants who are approved for funding.

The Foundation's activities are directed by its three officers:

- Lamont D. King, Treasurer

The Trustees meet quarterly and as necessary to make funding decisions and to review the progress of current grantees.
