STATEMENT 10

Introduction

The *Malcolm Wesley and Anna Geary Myers Scholarship Trust* was established in 1997 by the Estate of Anna Geary Myers.

Malcolm W. Myers and Anna Geary Myers were married for more than 65 years, and resided in the Borough of Hanover, York County, Pennsylvania. Mr. Myers died on August 29, 1988, and Mrs. Myers died on April 22, 1995. Mr. Myers was a graduate of Penn State University and Mrs. Myers was a graduate of Central State Normal School (now Lock Haven University). Mr. Myers was a businessman, associated with Hanover Shoe Company for many years, and Mrs. Myers, prior to her marriage to Mr. Myers, was a school teacher. Mr. and Mrs. Myers were active members of the Emmanuel United Church of Christ in Hanover, Pennsylvania, and were members of the Hanover Country Club. Both Mr. and Mrs. Myers were active members in many charitable organizations in the Borough of Hanover and consistently provided financial support for those charities. Having had no children, Mrs. Myers wanted to be sure that her and her husband's assets were used to assist deserving college-bound Hanover area high school students in their pursuit of higher education.

How much are the scholarship awards?

Scholarship awards are one-time awards for \$4,000 each.

To whom are scholarships provided?

To needy and deserving graduating students from the senior class of Hanover High School and South Western High School who demonstrate the following characteristics:

- (1) desire to pursue a higher education in colleges or universities of good standing within the continental United States;
- (2) likely to succeed as students;
- (3) who are likely to make the best citizens of the United States.

Note: By law, no relatives of the Awarding Committee (e.g. The Superintendent of the Hanover Public School District and South Western Area School District) may be recipients of the scholarship awards.

How are scholarship award recipients selected?

Each student submits a formal application and related documents by April 1 and a copy of his/her Free Application for Federal Student Aid form. The Awarding Committee, comprised of the Superintendent of Hanover Public School District, the Superintendent of South Western Area School District and a person nominated by the Trustee (CoreStates Bank, N.A.) makes the awards, without regard to race, color or creed, based on the information submitted by the applicant. Furthermore, all applicants must have a favorable recommendation submitted by the appropriate high school principal.

Students' scholastic records, leadership/participation in school and community activities, and financial need are important factors in the decision making process.

How are scholarship awards allocated between the two high schools (Hanover/South Western)?

The pool of funds available to be awarded is allocated to graduating seniors of the two high schools, based on the ratio of each school's number of graduating seniors to the total number of graduating seniors from both high schools.

What do the scholarship awards pay for?

Awards may be used to pay for tuition, room and board, books or other expenses necessary for the program of study.

How is the financial aid paid?

Funds will be paid directly to the institution that the student plans to attend.

When are the awards made?

Awards will be announced prior to graduation by the Awarding Committee or its designees.

Will the scholarships be renewed?

No - Although the trust agreement gives the Awarding Committee discretion to renew scholarship awards, the Awarding Committee has decided to restrict scholarships to graduating seniors only.

Where do I get an application?

Interested persons should obtain an application (and related documents) from the high school guidance department.

One-time scholarships in the amount of \$4,000 each will be granted to needy and deserving graduating students from the senior class of the two high schools in Hanover, PA (Hanover High School and Southwestern High School) who will likely succeed as college students and make the best citizens of the United States. The award must be used by the recipient to pursue a college or university education within the continental United States.

TERMS OF SCHOLARSHIP USE:

Awards must be used to cover tuition, room and board, books or other expenses necessary for the program of study. Scholarships will be paid directly to the institution the graduating student attends. All such institutions must be described within Section 170(b)(1)(A)(ii) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

GIFT OR LOAN:

All scholarships are to be in the form of grants directly to the institution attended by the award recipient.

HOW THE AVAILABILITY OF SCHOLARSHIPS WILL BE PUBLICIZED:

Brochures and applications will be made available to the students through the guidance office at the respective high schools and their availability will be publicized through school newspapers. See Exhibit C.

HOW SCHOLARSHIP AWARD RECIPIENTS WILL BE SELECTED:

Each student submits a formal application by April 1 and a copy of his or her Free Application for Federal Student Aid Form. An Awarding Committee, comprised of the Superintendent of Hanover Area School District, the Superintendent of Southwestern Area School District, and a person nominated by the Trustee (CoreStates Bank, N.A.) makes the awards without regards to race, color or creed, based on the information submitted by the applicants and recommendations submitted by the Principals of Hanover High School and Southwestern High School.

Students' scholastic record, financial need and school and community leadership/participation are expected to be important factors in awarding scholarships to recipients.

2. LIMITATIONS OR RESTRICTIONS APPLICABLE TO SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

Scholarships will be awarded to any student without regard to race, color or creed, who qualifies as needy and deserving, based on financial information provided by the students, their scholastic records and their leadership/participation in school or community activities.

The only criterion that the applicant must meet, according to the Will of Anna Geary Myers, are that the student must:

- be a deserving and needy graduating student from either the senior classes of Hanover High School or Southwestern High School;
- desire to pursue (and in fact do pursue) a higher education at a college or university of good standing in the continental United States;
- likely succeed as a student;
- make one of the best citizens of the United States.

The application process requires students to provide detailed information about their and their parents' occupation, annual income and expenses, scholastic record, and school/community activities in order for the Awarding Committee to make their determination as to deserving and needy award recipients.

3. PROCEDURES TO SUPERVISE GRANTS

Presently, since no awards have been made, no procedures have been developed to supervise grants. Due diligence efforts are in place to assure that the students have been accepted by a qualifying college or university (by requiring a copy of the acceptance letter) and that scholarship awards will be paid directly to the institution rather than to the recipients. It is anticipated that these institutions will agree to use the funds to defray the expenses described above or pay the funds (or portion thereof) to the recipient only if the recipient is then enrolled and his or her standing is consistent with the purposes and conditions of the scholarship within the meaning of Treas. Reg. Section 53.4945-4(c)(2). If any funds are diverted, the Applicant will take all reasonable and appropriate steps to recover the diversion within Treas. Reg. Section 53.4945-4(c)(4).
